 1,110' of 48"-54" New Storm Sewer \$3.6 M



### I&I Reduction Projects - \$5 Million

13 miles of public main sanitary sewers lining to reduce sewer backups

Area Bounded By N. Hawley Rd. to N. Honey Creek Pkwy. and W. Bluemound Rd. to W. Dickenson St.

66,000 FT of 8" to 12" Dia. Sanitary Sewer Lining - \$2.35 M

Sanitary Manholes inspection and rehabilitation - \$1.0 M

MMSD Private Property Inflow and Infiltration - \$1.65 M
