C. CSRC School Scorecard

This year, Cyber scored 73.1% on the pilot scorecard compared with 83.4% on the 2015–16 pilot scorecard. This met the CSRC expectation that schools scoring above 70.0% on the 2015–16 pilot scorecard would maintain at least 70.0% in the current year.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

The school addressed all of the recommendations in its 2015–16 programmatic profile and educational performance report. Based on results in this report and consultation with school staff, CRC recommends that the school continue a focused school improvement plan through the following activities.

- Seeking funding for the virtual reality lab;
- Implementing the continuous improvement program; and
- Successfully completing the transition of the school's leadership.

IV. RECOMMENDATION FOR ONGOING MONITORING AND REPORTING

Based on current and past contract compliance, completion of the recommended school improvement activities and the scorecard results, CRC recommends that Central City Cyberschool of Milwaukee continue regular, annual academic monitoring and reporting. In addition, CRC recommends that Central City Cyberschool be granted a new five-year contract to operate as a City of Milwaukee charter school.

VI. SUMMARY/RECOMMENDATIONS

This report covers the 18th year of Central City Cyberschool's operation as a City of Milwaukee charter school. Based on past and current contract compliance, completion of the recommended school improvement activities and the school's current scorecard results, CRC recommends that Central City Cyberschool continue regular, annual academic monitoring and reporting. In addition, CRC recommends that Central City Cyberschool be granted a new five-year contract to operate as a City of Milwaukee charter school.
