REASON FOR REQUEST:

Isiah Hargrove, a City of Milwaukee – Department of Public Works employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling southbound on North Sherman Boulevard. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Hampton Avenue and North Sherman Boulevard, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on West Hampton Avenue, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the red traffic light, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Hargrove sustained injuries to his back and left index finger. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$3,983.80.
