



# Forward Exam English/Language Arts 2016–17: Proficient or Advanced (3rd – 8th Grades)




# Forward Exam Math 2016–17: Proficient or Advanced (3rd – 8th Grades)


#### Average Composite ACT Scores: 2015–16 Graduates




#### 2015–16 Four-Year Graduation Rates
