Dear Mr. Fears:

We have conducted a follow up phone interview and checked references for the apparent low bidder for Official Notice No. 57828 – Bohmann & Vick Inc.

During our conversation the contractor demonstrated proficiency and knowledge of the general requirements for this type of utility and infrastructure construction project. The contractor is aware of the difficult phasing and coordination issues that will accompany their work. Additionally, the supplied references included in the bid forms confirmed positive recommendations.

The contractor has elected to install the StormTrap underground detention system, given that there was the opportunity to choose from alternative manufacturers. However the contractor is not experienced with the installation of their chosen manufacturer (StormTrap), which is a disadvantage in comparison to other contractors bidding on the project who have familiarity. However, they have experience with site utility and infrastructure construction, so this does not exclude them from consideration based on this fact alone.

The bid price of \$1,695,000 is below the Engineer's Opinion of Probable Cost of \$2,028,223. The bid price is within an acceptable range for this type of construction.

We thereby recommend the award of contract for this phase of work to Bohmann & Vick, Inc.
