Program Goals

Through utilization of the Nationwide Suspicious Activity Reporting Initiative (NSI), the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center (STAC) can utilize an “all crimes” approach to preventing crime and terrorism. The NSI provides a national capability to gather, document, process, analyze, and share information among various state, local, tribal, and federal agencies. The general public through the online WiWATCH Portal submits their criminal or terrorist activity observations through the Suspicious Activity Report (SAR).

The server houses the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center (STAC) and Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC) contact information and is used by citizens to report suspicious activity electronically by accessing the website.

The current STAC server is outdated and experiencing technical issues. Also provided is the “See Something, Say Something” information for the businesses and citizens for the entire State of Wisconsin, not just the STAC area of responsibility.

Programmatic Summary

This grant opportunity will provide funds to the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center (STAC) to purchase a new server for the WiWATCH Portal. Regular progress reports will be required, and the schedule for such reports will be included in the grant award materials, should funds be awarded. All personnel who utilize equipment purchased with funds from this grant must receive training either through the equipment vendor or other competent source. Required to maintain proper training records. Must maintain equipment records. Agency accepting funding are responsible for all sustainment costs.
