### Program Goals

Reduce crime and enhance quality of life through disrupting the illicit drug traffic in the Milwaukee metropolitan area by; immobilizing targeted violators and trafficking organizations, gather and report intelligence data relating to trafficking in narcotics and dangerous drugs, conduct undercover operations where appropriate, and engage in other traditional methods of investigation.

### Programmatic Summary

The purpose of this grant is to fund overtime expenses for two (2) MPD officers assigned to the DEA MDO Task Force in order that the Task Force's activities related to targeted violators and trafficking organizations will result in effective prosecution before the courts of the United States and the State of Wisconsin.

# Grant Award Summary

## 2017-2018 Drug Enforcement Administration Task Force

### Data

The data within the table below counts full year distinct drug arrests by the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) between January 1, 2014—December 31, 2016 and year to date (YTD) distinct drug arrests by MPD between January 1—November 30, 2016—2017. It should be noted that totals may not sum since an individual may be arrested for more than once charge and/or charge type. Furthermore, heroin arrests are inclusive of possession with intent to deliver and manufacturing and delivery, since possession of heroin falls under the scope of a Schedule I narcotic and cannot be determined.

For 2015—2016 total drug arrests by MPD declined 19%. The decline in marijuana arrests (-22%) contributed significantly to the decline in total drug arrests. MPD focused efforts on heroin arrests (+10%) due to the increase in heroin use nationally and within the City of Milwaukee.

For 2016 YTD—2017 YTD total drug arrests by MPD remained stable. There remains a decline in marijuana arrests (-7%) however nearly all other categories of drug charge saw an increase, including increases in cocaine arrests (+32%) and heroin arrests (+23%).
