This report is written by Police Officer KUKOWSKI, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/29/14 at 2:43 am, Milwaukee police investigated an armed robbery that occurred at 1801 W Greenfield. Officers spoke with the clerk, Ranjit Singh, who stated a male entered the store armed with a knife and demanded money. Singh was able to lock himself in a room behind the counter and was also able to lock the suspect inside the store while he called for police. The suspect consumed some snack sticks and potato chips without paying for them and then began kicking at the door in attempts to get out from the store. While kicking the door, a metal rod broke off from the door and the suspect began using the rod to break the window of the door and exited the store. The suspect was apprehended shortly thereafter and identified by his state ID and charged with Arm Robbery and CDTP. Police spoke with the agent Muhammad Asim regarding this incident.

On 02/02/2016 an officer conducted follow up at RM Petroleum, 1801 W. Greenfield Av, regarding the Robbery Prevention course. The Health Department advised the officer the owner and clerks had not completed the course after being given three opportunities dating back to 04/27/2015. 

Observed were glass "tire gauges" which are used specifically as pipes to smoke crack cocaine, "Chore Boy" metal scrub brushes used as filters for crack pipes, and single condoms for sale. Police spoke with Muhammad Asim and advised him what these items are used for and that selling these items are contributing to crime and facilitating the illicit drug activity that is bringing down the neighborhood. Asim said that he cannot control what people use the items for once they buy them.



This report is written by PO Matthew DIENER, assigned to District 2, early shift, squad 2266. On Sunday, July 16, 2017, at approximately 1:30pm, squad 2266 (DIENER, JUSTUS) conducted a business check at R M Petroleum, located at 1801 W Greenfield Av. Upon entering we observed that the store sells numerous items associated with and used for drug use and prostitution related activities. These items observed were glass "tire gauges" which are used specifically as pipes to smoke crack cocaine, "Chore Boy" metal scrub brushes used as filters for crack pipes, and single condoms for sale. I explained to the licensee, Muhammad ASIM, what these items are used for and that selling these items are contributing to the crime and facilitating the illicit drug activity that is bringing down the W Greenfield Av neighborhood. ASIM said that he cannot control what people use the items for once they buy them.

- 3. INCIDENT A police officer received anonymous information about a person dealing drugs (cocaine) inside the tavern, JJ Brothers, 2644 So 13th Street. The informant gave the officer a description of the suspect. The officers conducted a follow up, 3-23-05, at 11:28PM, on this information and observed a subject matching the description. He admitted to the officers that he had illegal drugs in his pocket. The officers found seven clear corner cut baggies containing white powder which tested positive for Cocaine (2.69 grams). The subject has a prior conviction for Cocaine. One arrest Possession of Controlled Substance. Report filed.
- 4. On 12/29/07 at 2:30 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2644 S 13th Street for a Shooting complaint. Investigation revealed a patron got into a verbal argument with other patrons while inside the tavern. As the victim exited the tavern at closing time, two unknown males exited a vehicle and shot the victim once in the ankle. The victim was intoxicated and refused to cooperate with police.
- 5. On 01/01/08 at 9:20 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 2644 S 13<sup>th</sup> Street. Officers spoke to Jorge Diaz-Anavitate and asked Diaz-Anavitate for the alcohol invoices for the last two years. Diaz-Anavitate could not provide the invoices stating they were at home. Diaz-Anavitate was advised by law the invoices must be left on the premises. Also found were 16 bottles of liquor that were contaminated and destroyed on scene by Diaz-Anavitate.
- 6. On 01/17/08 at 7:20 pm, Milwaukee police along with SA GeorgeAnn King from the Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco conducted a tavern check at 2644 S 13th Street. SA King spoke with Diaz-Anavitate and requested to see the last two years of alcohol invoices. Diaz-Anavitate stated he did not have the invoices and that he purchases his alcohol from Oklahoma Liquor. A total of 52 sealed bottles were ceased and 112 open bottles of liquor were confiscated due to being illegally purchased. SA King issued a warning to Diaz-Anavitate regarding purchasing alcohol illegally.
- 7. On 05/17/08 at 12:09 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2644 S 13<sup>th</sup> Street for a Battery complaint. Officers spoke with the victim who stated her ex-husband entered the tavern while she was there and they began talking. The victim stated everything was okay until her ex-husband started talking about getting back together and that is when the victim refused to talk with him any further. The victim further stated that her ex-husband then chased her out of the tavern and attacked her on the sidewalk in front of the bar. The suspect was later arrested. During the investigation, the tavern had closed and officers were unable to talk to the tavern owner. On Friday, 05/23/08, officers made contact with Jorge Diaz who stated that once the argument started in the bar, he asked the male to leave after the female had already left. Diaz stated that he was unaware that a battery had taken place. Diaz also stated he was bartending that night but did not call police.

8. On 08/23/10 at 8:30 pm, Milwaukee police conducted follow up regarding a complaint of extension of premise at 2644 S 13th Street. Officers attempted to enter the bar and found that the door was locked. Police looked in through the tavern window and observed 5 patrons inside the bar being served alcohol. Police knocked on the door and the licensee, Jorge Diaz, left from behind the bar and unlocked the door. Diaz was advised that the door must remain unlocked during business hours. Diaz stated he locked the door to "keep bad people out". Officers also found that patrons were outside at the rear of the bar entering the tavern with alcohol beverages in their hands. Diaz was also advised that he would need an extension premise permit if he wanted to have patrons drinking outside of the tavern. The applicant was issued a citation for License Premises-Safe Egress Required at 2644 S 13<sup>th</sup> Street.

10. On 12/01/11 officers investigated an Entry at J.J. Brothers Tavern at 2644 S. 13<sup>th</sup> St. While the tavern was closed unknown actors smashed out the glass of the front door to gain entry. The actors pried open the jukebox and removed the money box.

11.On 07/23/12 at 1:51pm, an officer was dispatched to 2644 S. 13<sup>th</sup> St. for theft of a firearm. The officer interviewed the applicant who is the owner of JJ Brothers Tavern. The applicant stated the theft happened on 07/13/12, but he waited to call the police hoping someone would return it. On 07/13/12 at approximately 10:00pm, the actor arrived and the tavern and went behind the bar. He stated there were a few customers in the bar at that time. The applicant removed the gun (Accu-Tek II .380 caliber semi-automatic) from his holster and placed it in a small backpack, which also contained \$200 in cash. He placed the backpack on a hook underneath the bar. It wasn't until after he was done cleaning up at approximately 3:00am, the applicant realized the backpack was gone. 

12. On 01/26/2014 a Milwaukee police officer, while on routine patrol, observed a group of people gathered outside JJ Brothers (2644 South 13<sup>th</sup> Street). This group of approximately 20 people was on the sidewalk in front of the business as well as in the street blocking traffic and directly across from the business. Four to five of the people in the group appeared to be arguing and attempting to provoke a fight. It took approximately six Milwaukee police squads to disperse the crowd. The officer spoke to the bartender at JJ Brothers who stated there had been an argument inside the business earlier, and the patrons had been pushed outside. The bartender told the officer that the no one from the business had called police because they were concerned a report would be filed.

This report was written by PO Ester KREMSEROVA, assigned to District 2, Late Power Shift.

On Friday, October 21, 2016, while assigned to Squad 2462, at approximately 11:48 pm, I was dispatched to a shots fired complaint at J J Brothers tavern at 2644 S 13th St, in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Unknown suspect charged at an unknown male subject inside of the tavern (left location before police arrival), with a knife. When escorted out by Rafael A TRINIDAD-RIOS (w/m, 9/23/1958) suspect still held the knife in his hand and said to TRINIDAD-RIOS, "If you get into it, I'll stab you too". TRINIDAD-RIOS locked the entrance door so the suspect would not be able to get back in.

Approximately 15 minutes later, suspect returned to the location, and from the outside, broke out two windows. Suspect then fled the scene in his vehicle, going northbound on S 13th St.

Owner of JJ Brothers, identified as Jorge L DIAZ (w/m, 12/31/1950) was on scene during the incident. DIAZ had owned the listed tavern for 14 years and had German Town insurance. The broken windows were double paned, 35 in by 12 in size and estimated at \$500 each.

Andrea RODRIGUEZ (w/f, 2/4/1949) was also on scene during the incident. RODRIGUEZ attempted to grab the knife from the suspect during the altercation. RODRIGUEZ suffered a small cut, not requiring stitches, to her right hand, and refused medical. RODRIGUEZ did not wish to prosecute. There were no other injuries reported.

While on scene, I did not observed any visible violations and DIAZ was cooperative.
