Your Class A Malt, Food Dealer, and Weights & Measures License Applications as agent for "Multani Food Market LLC" for "Multani Food Market" 51 W Hampton Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

to object to Multani Food Market obtaining a Malt license.


At this time we would not like to see so much beer and liquor distribution in our neighborhood.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 1/3/2018 at 11:15 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.







On Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at approximately 11:15PM I and my partner P.O. Patricia MOODY were dispatched to the address of 2909 W Fond Du Lac Ave for an armed robbery (carjacking) complaint.

After speaking with the victim, Jameelah R REYNOLDS (b/f, 12-28-94), and establishing that the crime occurred on the property, I attempted to speak with the cashier on duty, Singh SUKHWINDER (w/m, 3-10-68). SUKHWINDER stated that he would not be able to show us any surveillance footage regarding the crime because the exterior video cameras were not operational.

3. On 12/29/14 at 11:12 pm, Milwaukee police responded to 2624 W Lisbon Avenue for a Shotspotter that occurred at 1843 N 30th Street. Investigation revealed a vehicle left N 30th Street at a high rate of speed and entered the parking lot of 2624 W Lisbon. The driver exited the auto and walked into the store, despite officers ordering the driver to stay in the car. The subject then entered the gas station and officers observed the subject walk to one area of the store and shortly thereafter, exited and attempted to re-enter his car, when officers arrested him. - 7. On 03/27/16 at 3:21 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2624 W Lisbon Avenue. Investigation revealed a subject inside the station had a gunshot wound to the right shoulder. The victim has entered the station to make a purchase and when exiting, the suspect came from behind the gas pumps and pointed a gun at the victim and fired from close range, striking the victim. Both subjects began to fight with the suspect fleeing from the area. The incident was caught on video surveillance. Officers were unable to make contact with the owner of the premise.
- 8. On 01/05/17 at 9:03 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 27th and Lisbon for a battery complaint. Upon arrival, police located the victim on the sidewalk in the 1800 block of N 27th Street. A witness observed the incident and provided a statement to police.

"PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Markel MCKINLEY, assigned to district three, Neighborhood Impact Team early shift.

On Thursday, September 21st, 2017, at approximately 6:20pm, while assigned to squad 3281, my squad partner (P.O Jason DEWITT) and I, along with squad 3283 (P.O. Matthew LINK) and squad 3269 (P.O. Ryan DEWITT and P.O. Arttivus BRADFORD) were conducting a drug related investigation at 2624 W Lisbon Avenue (City and County of Milwaukee).

It should be noted that squad 3269 was operating in an unmarked squad car, while dressed in fully Milwaukee Police uniform. All other squads (3281 and 3283) were operating in fully marked squad cars while dressed in full Milwaukee Police uniform.

During the course of the investigation, P.O. J. DEWITT and I drove through the parking lot, to check for autos and/or occupants loitering outside of the gas station.

The aforementioned area is known for street sales of illegal drugs. Street dealers commonly loiter in or near parked vehicles, outside vacant houses or on front porches of residences while conducting drug sales. Street dealers are commonly armed or have a weapon readily available to them. I have made and taken part in numerous drug arrests and drug investigations as well as recovered firearms in and around this area. Also, I am familiar with "Call ahead" drug deals, in which users contact dealers via cell phone (typically text messages) and arrange a meet location for the transaction. Often in these transactions, the user(s) arrive prior to the dealer and loiter in a vehicle while waiting for the dealer.

AS P.O. J. DEWITT and I were exiting the gas station lot, I observed a silver in color vehicle with no front plate and one white female subject seated in the front passenger seat. The auto was parked facing eastbound alongside the southerly boundary of the gas station property. The auto was not parked near and gas pumps. Based on the above listed circumstance, squad 3269 began to conduct surveillance, on the above listed auto.

Squad 3283, along with P.O. J. DEWITT and I, positioned our squad out of line of sight gas station, and awaited updates from squad 3269.

After approximately two minutes, of staging, squad 3269, P.O. R. DEWITT informed us that he observed a suspected hand-to hand drug transaction, between two subjects inside the gas station lot.

P.O. R. DEWITT stated that a black male subject wearing a white undershirt and blue jeans, had conducted suspected drug transaction with a white male wearing a black tee-shirt and baseball cap. P.O. R. DEWITT stated that he believed the suspected dealer whom was conducting these illegal drug transactions, was accompanied by a black male subject whom was wearing a red shirt.

At that time all squads responded to the gas station lot, in order to conduct a field interview and the above listed subjects. It should be noted that prior to making contact with the individuals each of the above listed subject had entered different autos.

The above described subjects during the course of the investigation were revealed as the following:

Daronte T. TREADWAY (b/m 03-26-97). TREADWAY was the subject wearing the white undershirt whom engaged in the suspected hand to hand drug transaction

James N. MYERS (w/m 08-04-92). MYERS was the subject wearing a black shirt, baseball cap, whom was observed engaged in the suspected hand to hand with TREADWAY.

Larodney S. RAYMOND (b/m 03-26-97) was identified as the subject wearing the red shirt.

Lee K. MILLER (w/f 03-24-93) was the subject observed seated in the front passenger seat of the above described auto.

As officers entered the gas station, I observed MYERS whom was the only subject matching the description given by P.O. R. DEWITT seated in the front drivers seat of the auto MILLER had still been seated within. I informed P.O. LINK of my observation, at which time P.O. LINK conducted a field interview of the auto and occupants, for the suspected illegal drug transaction as well as no front plate violation.

During the course of the investigation it was revealed that MYERS and MILLER were seated in a 2002, silver in color Hyundai with WI plates 698-ZKS affixed to the rear of the auto.

While driving through the parking lot, I initially did not observe the subjects whom P.O. R. DEWITT had described walking in the parking lot. At that time, P.O. J. DEWITT along with squad 3269, began to check autos, due to ensure the subjects had not left the gas station lot, prior to our arrival.

It should be noted that squad 3281, and 3283 took approximately 10 seconds to enter the gas station lot after P.O. R. DEWITT'S observation.

AS P.O J. DEWITT and I began to check the Southside Autos for the subjects, I observed RAYMOND seated in the front driver's seat of a white in color minivan. The auto in which RAYMOND was seated in did not have a front or rear plate affixed to the auto. RAYMOND made eye contact with me, and quickly made a reaching movement towards his waistband, with both hands while leaning forwards towards the steering wheel. RAYMOND's actions were consistent with concealing or retrieving a weapon or contraband.

I informed P.O. J. DEWITT of my observation at which time; we conducted a field interview of the auto and occupants. It should be noted that as I approached the auto, I observed TREADWAY seated in the rear passenger seat.

It should be noted that RAYMOND and TREADWAY were occupants of a white, 2001, Mazda MTV, minivan bearing Wisconsin Plates of 915-ZRJ.

While making contact with both RAYMOND and TREADWAY, P.O. LINK made contact with MYERS and MILLER. While speaking with MYERS, MYERS informed P.O. LINK that TREADWAY had approached him and offered MYERS a free sample of illegal narcotics. MYERS stated that TREADWAY offered him a free sample of "boy or girl".

It should be noted I know the above listed terms to be slang for heroin ("Boy") and cocaine ("girl").

While P.O LINK spoke with MYERS and MILLER, P.O. BRADFORD and I made contact with TREADWAY and RAYMOND. Based on the movements and suspected drug transactions and the odor of burnt marijuana in the Mazda, all subjects were removed from the respective auto. I informed TREADWAY of the reason why he was being removed from the auto, at which time he complied by exiting the vehicle. As TREADWAY exited the auto, P.O. LINK gave me a non-verbal signal at which time TREADWAY was detained.

After TREADWAY was detained, I then spoke with both MYERS and MILLER. MYERS, whom was initially deceptive, later admitted that he had been in the area to "score" and sell a car. MYERS stated that he stopped at the gas station, to use the bathroom and purchase water. MYERS stated that as he exited the gas station, he was approached by TREADWAY whom asked him, if he "partied". MYERS informed me that he did not accept drugs from subjects that he did not know. MYERS stated that he informed TREADWAY, that he did not want any narcotics, and continued to walk towards his auto. MYERS stated that TREADWAY continued to pressure

him into a drug sale. MYERS stated that TREADWAY offered him a free sample of "boy", and told MYERS to following him around the corner on foot, in order to receive narcotics. MYERS stated that TREADWAY informed him, that he had observed the police in the area and did not wish to conduct his business in the parking lot. MYERS stated that while speaking with TREADWAY he observed a fully marked squad car, at which time he decided to walk away from TREADWAY and entered his auto. MYERS stated that moments after entering his auto, he was stopped by the police. MYERS denied any exchange of money for narcotics.

I know the term "score" to be slang, for purchase illegal narcotics and "party" to be slang for use of illegal narcotics.

At that time both MILLER and MYERS were removed from the auto and a search of the auto was conducted. Located in a backpack on near the center console of the auto, was a black in color zippered pouch. Inside of the pouch, I located two orange capped syringes, and a blue rubber tie off. Both of the previously described items are consistent with the use of illegal narcotics.

During the course of the investigation, a standard warrant check revealed MILLER was currently on probation, and an order to detain was placed on MILLER.

A standard check revealed that TREADWAY is currently on probation, and an order to detain was place on TREADWAY by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections.

It should be noted that prior to speaking with MYERS and MILLER I informed officers on scene of my observations of RAYMONDs actions. P.O. BRADFORD stood by with RAYMOND of majority of the investigation. While on scene P.O. BRADFORD informed RAYMOND of my observations, RAYMOND denied having any narcotics on his person.

TREADWAY, RAYMOND and MILLER were arrested and conveyed to district three for processing. MYERS was released from the scene.

Upon arrival to district three, RAYMOND informed P.O. BRADFORD that he had in fact concealed illegal substances in his pants, prior to police making contact with his auto. RAYMOND whom was inside the district three booking room, at the time, willing removed a clear plastic bag sandwich bag from his pants. at which time P.O. BRADFORD took control of suspected narcotics. Located in the clear plastic bag where a total of three clear plastic corner cuts, each contained an off-white chunky substance suspected crack cocaine.

While at District Three, PO R. DEWITT subjected a sample of the suspected crack cocaine to a field test (NarkII07) and determined the substance to test positive for cocaine base and have a total weight of 7.61 grams. The amount of narcotics recovered is consistent with street level sales and distribution.



- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
