There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.



If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. The applicant owes the city of Milwaukee \$730.00 for overdue parking citations.
2. On 02/20/2013 Karen Hubbard was cited at 4405 North 36<sup>th</sup> Street in the city of Milwaukee for Building Code Violations.

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3. On 04/25/2015 Milwaukee police, along with a representative from the Department of Neighborhood Services, and agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street. During this check, it was discovered that the person working behind the bar, Shakira Loggin, does not have a valid Class D operator's license. 2 bottles of alcohol, 5 containers of tobacco and 4 cash register receipts were confiscated by state agents. The applicant was cited for Responsible Person on Premises Required.

4. On 07/26/2015 Milwaukee police responded to an accident at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street. Investigation revealed that a subject employed as security for the business (The Kiss Ultra Lounge) was helping to break up a fight when he was struck by a vehicle.
5. On 09/06/2015 at 2:15am Milwaukee police were monitoring Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street) when they observed a male patron punch a female patron in the face. The male patron was arrested and issued a citation for assault and battery.

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Item #3 previously reported, disposition added 11/11/2016.

6. On 11/07/2015 Milwaukee police, who were assigned at Kiss Ultra Lounge, overheard patrons talking about a fight inside the tavern. One of the involved parties was cited for disorderly conduct.
7. On 11/29/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a tavern check at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge). While in route, officers were advised to hasten their response as several patrons had become unruly and disorderly. Moments later, squads began broadcasting that several gunshots had been fired in the area of North 76<sup>th</sup> Street and West Clinton Avenue. Employees of the business told officers that security had broken up a fight inside the bar and escorted the involved patrons out. The fight continued in the parking lot until security intervened. Moments after the involved subjects dispersed, several shots were heard. No additional evidence, complainants or witnesses were discovered.
8. On 12/06/2015 Milwaukee police were monitoring Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street) when security notified them that several patrons were involved in a fight inside the business. Three subjects were cited for disorderly conduct. 8 Milwaukee police squads, in addition to the squad that had been monitoring, along with 2 Milwaukee police supervisors responded to assist in controlling the situation.
9. On 12/12/2015 Milwaukee police met with the applicant to address incidents that had occurred at Kiss Ultra Lounge recently. The applicant stated the following actions would be taken:
  - Both exits at the front of the business will be utilized.
  - The patio door will also be used as an exit for patrons.
  - Security gates will be set up in the parking lot.
  - An armed roaming security guard will be added.

Additionally, cameras have been installed at the entrance and inside the venue and two members of the security staff that had been doing a substandard job had been terminated and replaced.

10. On 01/08/2016 Milwaukee police met with the applicant regarding recent incidents at Kiss Ultra Lounge. The applicant stated that she had been hiring two off duty officers for Friday and Saturday evenings, but these officers had recently stopped coming. She asked that officers be notified and trained on how to sign up for this work detail. She further stated she had fired two security guards and she was willing to work with Milwaukee police in keeping her establishment safe.

11. On 01/10/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down regarding a trouble with a subject complaint at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge). Officers were told there had been a dispute inside the business and the involved parties were removed from the premises by security. These parties continued to argue in the parking lot of the business until security intervened along with Milwaukee police. The involved parties later cooperated with security and left the area. The officer reports that business staff was very cooperative and helpful.

12. On 02/07/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down regarding a fight inside Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street). Investigation revealed a patron of the business had been involved in a fight. Security for the business intervened and detained the subject until police arrived. This subject lied about his identity and threatened to "air the club out". This subject was arrested. During this encounter, Milwaukee police became aware there was a pending battery complaint that occurred at 76<sup>th</sup> and Mill Road. The officer responded to St. Joseph's hospital to investigate. The officer spoke to Brittany Morton who stated she had been a patron of Kiss Ultra Lounge (7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street) when she and a former friend got into a fight. One of the involved parties was struck in the head with a glass sustaining an injury to her head. Milwaukee police incident report #160380036 was filed.

13. On 02/13/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to St. Mary's hospital for a battery that occurred at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge). The victim states she had been involved in a fight while in the main room of the bar. She sustained an abrasion to her forehead. Milwaukee police incident report #160440026 filed.

14. On 04/10/2016 Milwaukee police, who were working a special assignment at 7330 North 76<sup>th</sup> Street (Kiss Ultra Lounge), were asked by security personnel to assist with removal of a group of individuals from the business's parking lot. Officers discovered a group of approximately ten subjects in a circle fighting in the rear parking lot. These subjects scattered as officers approached which revealed a male lying on the ground bleeding from the head. This subject received medical attention from Milwaukee Fire Department Engine #39. The subject refused to speak to officers and walked away. Milwaukee police incident report #161010016 filed.

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15. On 11/20/2016 officers responded to Kiss Ultra Lounge, 7330 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St for a Trouble with Subject complaint. The officers observed a subject holding open the door arguing with security. The subject was intoxicated and refused to pay the cover charge because he stated he paid for a VIP area. The subject did leave without incident. Security was cooperative and no violations were observed.

16. On 12/04/2016 at 2:05am officers were observing closing time at Kiss Ultra Lounge, 7330 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St. Patrons advised the officers that there were several people who were about to fight. The officers observed a subject yelling in another patrons face and that he was preparing to strike the patron. The subject was causing a disturbance and was cited for Disorderly Conduct.
17. On 04/02/2017 at 2:20am officers were monitoring traffic at Kiss Ultra Lounge, 7330 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St. The officer observed a group of 30 subjects surrounding a car. The car had a broken windshield and fled when the officer approached. The officer observed a subject carrying a large wooden table leg. The subject was arrested after a short foot chase. The manager, Craig BERRY, was cooperative and would press charges on the subject.
18. On 10/01/2017 officers received a call from Kiss Ultra Lounge that they were needed for trouble with subject. Upon arrival security was pointing at a subject in the parking lot stating that the subject had a gun. The officers stopped the two subjects by the car security was pointing at and recovered two firearms from the ground by the subjects. The manager, Craig BERRY, stated that he observed one of the subjects walking back and forth outside with a gun in his hand. Video surveillance was recovered which depicted the incident. Both subjects were arrested and no other violations were observed in the tavern.

This License Premise report is submitted by P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN, assigned to District Four, Squad 4365, Late Shift.

On Sunday, November 20, 2016, at 1:04 am, I, and P.O. Antony PRESTI responded as back up squad to a Trouble with Subject complaint at Kiss Ultra Lounge, 7330 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St. Upon arrival, P.O. PRESTI and I observed a male subject, later identified as Jose M. VARELA, h/m, 01-01-94, 2221 N 17<sup>th</sup> St, 414-788-9966. When P.O. PRESTI and I arrived on scene, VERELA was holding onto the northwest door of the establishment, demanding to be allowed entrance into the club. Security personnel had already asked VERELA to leave the premise numerous times, with him refusing to honor the club's request each time. According to VERELA, he paid money to one of the club owners for a VIP section inside the club, and as a result, thought he should have been allowed to enter the establishment without paying a cover charge. VERELA could not tell officers on scene (or security personnel for that matter) to whom he had paid the money. VERELA had arrived at the club via a party bus. VERELA was initially very loud and profane. He was also visibly intoxicated (which he even admitted). VERELA eventually calmed down and stated to P.O. PRESTI and myself that he didn't want to start any trouble. Officers on scene, myself, P.O. PRESTI, P.O. Nicholas REID and P.O. Nicholas SCHLEI, escorted VERELA (and his very belligerent sister) off the premise without incident. VERELA called for an Uber car and left the scene.

After club closing, I spoke with one of the owners of the establishment, Ralph JOHNSON, b/m, 02-21-65, who stated that he was informed by security personnel that VERELA was refusing to leave the premise. JOHNSON was told VERELA was claiming he paid money to someone for a VIP section for him and his party. JOHNSON stated he immediately checked with his fellow co-owners and other staff to find out if they had received any money from VERELA. JOHNSON stated no one had received any money from VERELA. JOHNSON stated that he was aware that a person in VERELA's group had paid for a VIP section and had paid for a certain amount of people to receive wristbands. These wristbands were to alert the club's security that a particular person had been invited to join the host inside of the club in the VIP section. It also indicated that this person should be allowed in without paying a cover charge. VERELA did not possess one of these wristbands.

It should be noted that the security personnel and staff at Kiss were extremely cooperative. According to the primary squad on scene, they displayed much patience and professionalism when dealing with VERELA. JOHNSON stated that other than this minor incident, there were no additional problems with any of the patrons on this night. No rule violations were observed while officers were on scene. A check of the establishment's license premise information revealed that all required documents were up to date and displayed in plain view behind the bar.

This License Premise report is submitted by P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN, assigned to District Four, Squad 4365, Late Shift.

On Sunday, December 4, 2016, at 2:05 am, P.O. Martinez MOORE and I were on scene monitoring the release of patrons at Kiss Ultra Lounge, located at 7330 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St. While conducting traffic control outside the club, P.O. MOORE and I heard Squad 4332 (P.O. Jonathan MILLER and P.O. Jeremy CARTER), come over the air and ask for additional squads to the parking lot area. Upon entering the parking lot area, P.O. MOORE and I observed a black male subject being escorted out the parking lot by P.O. MILLER and P.O. CARTER.. P.O. MILLER stated that while monitoring the parking lot and front entrance of the club, a group of patrons approached him and P.O. CARTER and informed them that several male subjects were about to fight. P.O. MILLER stated that the group of patrons pointed towards a group of black male subjects. P.O. MILLER stated that him and P.O. CARTER approached the subjects and specifically observed a subject, later identified as, Dalawrence M. TERRY, b/m, 03-05-88, 6649 W. Bourbon St., 808-5221, yelling into another subject's face. P.O. MILLER stated TERRY appeared as if he was preparing to strike the unknown subject. P.O. MILLER heard TERRY yell "Nigga!" then observed several people pulling TERRY away. This disturbance attracted a group of approximately twelve people. As TERRY was walking away, he was stopped and detained by police regarding this disturbance. TERRY was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct

It should be noted that the security personnel and staff at Kiss were cooperative. I spoke with one of the club owners Craig L. BERRY, who stated that other than this minor incident, there were no additional problems with any of the patrons on this night. No rule violations were observed by myself, P.O. MOORE or other officers on scene. A check of the establishment's license premise information revealed that all required documents were up to date and displayed in plain view behind the bar.

This Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises, original report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS#015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Sunday, April 2, 2017, at approximately 2:20 A.M., I was monitoring traffic control, and pedestrian movement, at Kiss Ultra Lounge, located at 7330 N. 76th St. Aforementioned address is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

During my monitoring, I observed a loud and boisterous crowd, of approximately 30 people, surrounding a gray vehicle near the entrance of Kiss Ultra Lounge. The windshield of aforementioned vehicle was shattered by the unruly crowd. Fearing that someone may be in need of immediate police assistance, I advised Milwaukee Police Department personnel to assist me on Kiss Ultra Lounge's parking lot. After making entry on the parking lot, I observed the gray vehicle flee northbound from the lot. Contemporaneous to the vehicle fleeing, I observed a subject, later identified as Dennis C MATTOX B/M, 05-18-87, walking through the crowd of patrons armed with a wooden table leg (later measured at 43") resting upon his shoulder. Fearing that Dennis MATTOX was about to assault someone with this massive blunt object, I drew my firearm and ordered MATTOX to drop his weapon. MATTOX looked at me, smiled, then continued to meter around parked cars. Afterwards, I was assisted by P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN and Sergeant Todd LEWAN. Dennis MATTOX then dropped the table leg then ran northbound through the parking lot with intent to evade arrest. After a short foot pursuit, Sergeant LEWAN deployed his taser, subsequently striking MATTOX upon his back, to gain compliance. During the ground handcuffing, MATTOX initially used passive resistance by refusing to place his hands behind his back. After giving a verbal command of "Stop Resisting!", MATTOX complied. MATTOX was subsequently summarily arrested then conveyed to St Joseph's Hospital, located at 5000 W Chambers St, for medical clearance. A subsequent wanted check revealed that MATTOX has a valid warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for possession of THC, warrant#2017003286.

Preceding our conveyance of MATTOX, I conducted an interview of Kiss Ultra Lounge Manager, identified as Craig L BERRY B/M, 11-17-67 address of 920 Lamplighter Ln; Grafton, WI 53024, cell phone# 262-343-5257. Craig BERRY advised me that he is willing to prosecute MATTOX for causing a disturbance at his establishment, without his consent. Furthermore, Craig BERRY was cooperative with our investigation. Dennis MATTOX was medically evaluated by Milwaukee Fire Department, ARV #1, Red Shift, Captain Tom HALUBER, for the prongs in his back.

While at St. Joseph's Hospital, MATTOX was medically treated by PA Dan MURPHY and his admittance time was 3:23 A.M.

This incident occurred in the City and County of Milwaukee and was cleared by arrest.

This License Premise report is submitted by P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN, assigned to District Four, Squad 4365, Late Shift.

On Sunday, October 4, 2017, at 1:25 am, my partner, P.O. Anthony PRESTI and I were contacted by Kiss Ultra Lounge staff requesting that we immediately return to the location, due to trouble with subjects (PO PRESTI and I had just conducted a tavern check at the location two minutes earlier). Upon arrival, P.O. PRESTI and I observed Kiss Ultra Lounge co-manager, Craig L. BERRY, b/m, 11-17-67, in the parking lot, frantically pointing towards a black male subject wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black pants and black and white gym shoes. This subject was walking on the passenger side, from the front to the rear, of a black, 4dr, 2012 Honda Accord, WI Plate of ABF 5214. BERRY stated "That's him in the black hoody!". BERRY also stated "He has a gun!"

P.O. PRESTI and I observed the above listed subject along with another black male. As soon as P.O. PRESTI and I exited our vehicle and approached the two subjects, I heard the sound of something that sounded like metal hitting the ground beside the above listed vehicle. P.O. PRESTI and I ordered the two subjects to the ground and momentarily detained both subjects. P.O. PRESTI conducted a search of the immediate area for weapons. P.O. PRESTI search yielded a 40 caliber black glock 27 that was under the passenger side of a vehicle parked right next to the above listed vehicle. P.O. PRESTI also observed a black 9 millimeter glock 19 on the ground, in front of the above listed vehicle, towards the passenger side. Both firearms were in close proximity of where we first observed the subjects.

The subject with the black hooded sweatshirt and observed on the passenger side of the above listed vehicle, was later identified as, Christopher A. WADDELL, b/m, 01-06-87, 8924 W. Palmetto Ave, 414-616- 6975. The other subject, standing on the driver side of the above listed vehicle was later identified as Marquis D. TOWNSEND, b/m, 10-18-80, 2214 W Neil Pl. TOWNSEND was wearing a black shirt and gray pants. WADDELL was observed by BERRY and Kiss Ultra Lounge co-manager Amari E. BROWN, b/m, 12-20-68, with a black handgun in his hand, walking back and forth in the establishment's parking lot. The establishment's video surveillance cameras (Cameras #1 and #2) also show WADDELL with a dark object in his right hand that appears to be a gun. TOWNSEND's is shown on camera bending over by the silver vehicle parked next to the above listed vehicle (and upon approaching, the sound of something metal hitting the concrete. WADDELL and TOWNSEND were taken into custody. TOWNSEND received medical attention while being detained on scene. It was decided that TOWNSEND should be conveyed to Froetert Hospital for further medical observation.

It should be noted that BERRY, who stated that other than this minor incident/. No rule violations were observed by myself, P.O. PRESTI or other officers on scene. A check of the establishment's license premise information revealed that all required documents were up to date and displayed in plain view behind the bar.





Assisting in this assignment was Lila JOHNSON (B/F, 12/01/99, of 2633 N. 23<sup>RD</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53206). JOHNSON is 16 years of age which is not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 11:10am, JOHNSON entered GP Petroleum LLC / BP at 5990 W Good Hope Road and purchased a pk/box of Newport 100 cigarettes. JOHNSON described the cashier as a A/F, wearing a pink shirt. I entered the store and immediately identified the cashier based on the description given.
