RE: Late Night Construction Noise/Lighting and Late Night Bar Noise

Dear Alderman Bauman:

For the past several years, since the Whiskey Bar opened for business, the lingering "bar closing" noise and related street traffic between midnight and 2 am has become an increasingly irritating event, particularly on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.

In addition, the most recent Northwestern Mutual Insurance tower being build across the street has ADDED to the bar noise issues, with late into the night construction and high intensity lights that shine directly throughout the night, making it almost impossible to fall asleep.

When our mixed-use building was completed, it was reported in the Journal Sentinel as a great blend of office space, businesses AND residential. If that vision is still alive, you and the City of Milwaukee have a responsibility to balance the concerns and wellbeing of your residents with those of downtown businesses. Residents like us have invested our money to live, work and play in Milwaukee's downtown and we collectively pay significant property taxes for that privilege. We understand that we all have to "get along" and all I want is some reasonable understanding and balance with that of our business neighbors.

Possible interim solutions could be:

- 1. Have Northwestern Mutual's building site lights turned off by 9 or 10 PM.
- 2. Work with the Whiskey Bar to consider a different ingress and egress location. Or position a Milwaukee Police patrol car outside the Whiskey Bar between midnight and 2 AM on high traffic nights (Thursday-Saturday), to facilitate bar customers quieter and quicker departure. I'm confident that just the Police visibility in the area would accomplish our goal.

I believe we have already entered your previous communication as a complaint against the Whisky Bar so there will be a renewal hearing and you will get notice.

There are no specific state laws or city ordinances requiring any particular level of security at licensed premises. Typically security is a subject of a licensed premise plan of operations which is part of the license approval process. Lack of security can be raised at a renewal hearing and the council can require that a security plan be implemented as part of a license approval or renewal.

I need a couple of things, first, will you or your office please alert me via e-mail of any meetings regarding bar licensing hearings that would include the Whiskey Bar;

second, do you know if the City of Milwaukee has any requirements for bars or similar venues, requiring THEM to supply their own security personnel to handle their

crowd control and encourage their patrons to move away from the outside of their bar or? It's my understanding other cities and states have that kind of regulation.

If so, this would certainly be a positive solution to help control street noise levels late at night, as well as not having to shift that burden onto the City's police force.

Yes. I received it but there was no phone number or email address attached.

Regarding construction lights, there is no city regulation on this topic. The city does have a noise ordinance that restricts noise generating construction activity before 7 am and after 9 pm, Monday

through Saturday. If there is noise generating work occurring beyond these times DNS can respond to abate the activity and possibly issue citations.

NML can certainly direct their contractor to turn off the lights during non work times but the city has no authority to do so.

Regarding the Whiskey Bar, if there is excessive noise and disorder at closing time two thing can be done. First the police can be called to address the issues and possibly issue citations. Second we can enter a complaint in the licensing file for this bar which will trigger a hearing at license renewal time. At this hearing you and other neighbors can attend and testify regarding the level of disturbance caused by the bar. The committee can recommend renewal with a suspension or non-renewal of the license based on the testimony. I would suggest calling the police about this issue so there is a record of police calls. This police record is considered at the license renewal hearing.

Now that I have your letter electronically, I will enter it into the license file for the Whiskey Bar so there will be a hearing at the next renewal.

Dear Alderman Bauman:

For the past several years, since the Whiskey Bar opened for business, the lingering "bar closing" noise and related street traffic between midnight and 2 am has become an increasingly irritating event, particularly on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.

In addition, the most recent Northwestern Mutual Insurance tower being build across the street has ADDED to the bar noise issues, with late into the night construction and high intensity lights that shine directly i throughout the night, making it almost impossible to fall asleep.

When our mixed-use building was completed, it was reported in the Journal Sentinel as a great blend of office space, businesses AND residential. If that vision is still alive, you and the City of Milwaukee have a responsibility to balance the concerns and wellbeing of your residents with those of downtown businesses. Residents like us have invested our money to live, work and play in Milwaukee's downtown and we collectively pay significant property taxes for that privilege. We understand that we all have to "get along" and all I want is some reasonable understanding and balance with that of our business neighbors.

Possible interim solutions could be:

1. Have Northwestern Mutual's building site lights turned off by 9 or 10 PM.

2. Work with the Whiskey Bar to consider a different ingress and egress location. Or position a Milwaukee Police patrol car outside the Whiskey Bar between midnight and 2 AM on high traffic nights (Thursday-Saturday), to facilitate bar customers quieter and quicker departure. I'm confident that just the Police visibility in the area would accomplish our goal.

3. On 10/18/09 at 3:43 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 788 N Jackson Street for a Damage To Property complaint. Officers spoke Michael Vitucci who stated he and one of his employees observed a patron leave the tavern only to return, pick up the cash register and throw it to the ground smashing it. One employee was struck in the eyes by some flying pieces from the register. Employees detained the patron until police arrived. Officers spoke to the subject who admitted to breaking the register stating he would pay for it. Officers could smell alcoholic beverages on the subject's breath. This subject was arrested and charged with Criminal Damage to Property.

4. On 08/20/10 at 10:00 pm, Milwaukee police investigated a complaint at 788 N Jackson regarding excessive noise. 
This report is written by Police Officer Cullin Weiskopf, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift.

On the evening of Thursday March 30th, 2017 through the morning of Friday, March 31, 2017 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative, consisting of an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer monitoring from a short distance. The Police Aide was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. PA Jada Greer (PS 026047, 08/30/1997) and PO Kourtney Hartl (PS 022557) were in plainclothes, while PO Cullin Weiskopf (PS 017808) was in full uniform.

All plainclothes members of this initiative were advised they are not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth. The Police Officer was directed to produce ID, but the underage Police Aide was directed to not produce any form of identification. It was explained that the Police Aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes Police Officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

On March 31st, 2017, at 12:15 AM, PO Hartl and PA Greer attempted to gain entry to the class "B" licensed tavern, The Whiskey Bar, located at 788 N. Jackson St. PA Greer was denied entry by security at the entrance to the tavern.

On April 5th, 2017, at 8:48 PM, Police Officer Raymond Bogust informed Brandon R. Brandemuehl that the establishment successfully passed the initiative.
