Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. 

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

#### · Objection 1: Crime, disorder and antisocial behavior







#### Objection 3: Unauthorized parking and use of my property driveway:



On Thursday, October 27, 2016, the Historic Brewers Hills Association Board of Directors met with representatives of Triple Overtime Sports Bar. The business is proposed in the ground floor commercial space at 1806 N Martin Luther King Jr. Drive. The representatives from the business at the meeting included Deandre Perkins, Owner / Primary Stakeholder; Charles Weathersby, Security; and their advisor. They presented the executive summary of the proposed sports bar, describing the mission statement, guiding principles, and operational details, the management team, and short and long term business goals.

The Board of Directors welcomed the opportunity to meet and learn about the proposed business. While we appreciate the enthusiasm of the management team, we have strong concerns about the operation of the sports bar and the impact the operation of the sports bar may have on the surrounding neighborhood. Specifically, the points of concern are the lack of relevant operational experience by the Owner / Primary Stakeholder, the lack of a kitchen with the sports bar's opening date, the lack of a time frame as to when a kitchen will be installed, the purported cabaret error of the initial licensing application, and the operational ambiguities the Board noted during the representative's presentation. Additionally, the representatives stated that they are targeting patrons 25 years of age and older and that a DJ will not be used, but these are simply goals of Triple Overtime Sports Bar which will not be reflected as license contingencies.

To close, the Board of Directors recommends two action's relative to Triple Overtime Sports Bar. First, we suggest that the Triple Overtime Sports Bar meet with the Halyard Park Neighborhood Association because we believe it is important for the owners to meet with this neighborhood that borders their establishment. Second, we suggest that the above-stated business goals of Triple Overtime Sports Bar (e.g., having an operational kitchen upon the opening or attracting patrons 25 years or older) are included as specific contingencies in any and all Triple Overtime Sports Bar license applications.



- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
