Youth - Multi-Craft Core Curriculum Training

- 31 Milwaukee Public School Students from Bradley Tech and South Division are currently participated in MC3 Training held at Bradley Tech during the current school semester:
 - Class started January 3rd and is being held during classroom hours, allowing for dual MPS and MATC credit.

Adult - Multi-Craft Core Curriculum Training

- 11 adults participated in the MC3 Training held at MATC during fall:
 - Class started November 27th and ran through December 22nd.
 - 10 individuals completed class and earned their MC3 credential.
- Recruitment is currently underway for the MC3 Training to be held at MATC during spring:
 - Class is scheduled to run March 19th through
 April 18th at MATC.
