1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The purpose of this project is to enhance the Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) program in responding to online enticement of children by sexual predators. Another goal of this program is to increase the investigative capabilities of law enforcement officers and prosecutions of ICAC offenses. MPD will arrange for training to promote internet safety and education to increase public awareness, increase the number of ICAC offenses being prosecuted by the State of Wisconsin, and to create a multi-agency task force.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This resolution will enhance public safety and reduce and prevent crimes against children in the City of Milwaukee.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

The mission of the ICAC is to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of investigations and prosecutions of Internet crimes against children offenses, and to increase public awareness and prevention of ICAC offenses. Grant funds will be used to support overtime for ICAC investigations and equipment for conducting ICAC investigations and the forensics of digital media in ICAC investigations.

MPD will report to the DOJ, Division of Criminal Investigation on all ICAC statistics and dispositions on a quarterly basis. In addition, all activities performed by the assigned investigators will be reported to the National ICAC database on a monthly basis via an online portal. Activities include, the number of tips reported and investigated, documented child exploitation investigations and the types of community outreach performed.
