

Dear Mr. Ashanti Hamilton,

The purpose of this letter is designed to request permission to add CCA Campus to 35th street, from the boundaries between Villard and Rohr Streets. Dr. James and Andre Carter are the owners of Carter's Christian Academy, which is located at: 5268 N. 35th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The Carter's have been pillars of the Milwaukee community. As leaders, they are lauded in many circles as, entrepreneurs and trendsetters in the field of education. Their visionary leadership has an inspiring and inclusive leadership style, with strong emphasis on advocating and empowering our youth today, thus preparing them for future leadership positions in a global society tomorrow.

The Carter's have invested a lifetime commitment to making a difference in the lives of residents in zip codes; 53206 and 53209. Those investments include: Carter's Christian Academy Schools (CCA) site 1 and 2, Carter's International Academy, Carter's Christian Child Care Service, and the Trees of Righteousness International Church. An explanation of these community investments are listed below.

For the past twenty plus years, CCA served as many as 400 students daily, by providing a quality education. Many of these scholars **will be** first generation high school and/or college graduates. CCA faith-base curriculum reinforces positive value systems that are built and established on solid academic standards. The school began with fifteen K4 and K5 students, and now offers classes for approximately 400 students from K4 through 10th grade. CCA has (3) three locations; Site 1 at 5268 N35th Street, Site 2 at 2004 N 33rd Street and Site 3 at 8864 North 76th Place. Carter's Christian Academy would not exist without their diverse and distinguished group of scholars, who help make the school a notable and respected part of the Milwaukee community.

Carter's Christian Academy is a non-profit (5013C) school that is accredited through AdvancED. CCA offers a diverse, positive and nurturing climate to all students. We serve some of the most delightful, motivated, gifted and challenged children from various ethnic backgrounds. A major part of our vision is to ensure that students have an opportunity to create lasting memories through quality learning experiences. We have partnered with The Robotics Program through UW Extension, Stem101 program theatergram through Concordia University, Ballroom dancing through Mad Hot program, Pearls for Girls Etiquette Program, SDC Job Readiness Project as well as implementing an expanding technology program. We have partnered with a licensed therapist who comes in weekly to listen and interact with students who are facing traumatic situations in their homes and lives. Presently, we are focused on being a data driven educational facility that uses the data collected to assist in meeting the academic needs of the students and families. Being a data driven school, has provided us with ability to


communicate with parents and students regarding academic grades, daily performance while offering support and strategies to help students improve. Data analysis is one of the things that distinguishes Carter Christian Academy School from other schools.

Our students and staff are a community of learners who work together as a team to make sure that the vision of CCA is realized in the life of the student population, parental body and staff. Our goal is that every teacher and child at Carter's is enriched by just being part of our school. Developing a sense of community begins each morning as the children enter the building and start their day of learning with prayer and a uplifting assembly. Many of our students utilize the resources of the Milwaukee Library located on the corner of 35th Street on a consistent basis. We also collaborate with them and schedule times for our classes to attend and enjoy adventures in learning and research projects.

Although the instructional state standards are quite demanding, CCA has continued to grow and maintain an educational facility where children can receive a quality holistic education. Choice school are consistently under strenuous Department of Public Instruction (DPI) demands and guidelines that must be met for continued operation. It is through our faith in God and untiring labor we have been able to improve student performance. Carter's Christian Academy is swiftly developing into an innovative international school that offers an education that prepares students for life, builds families and provides them with the tools needed to be outstanding members of our society, community and world.

Our future looks bright and our plans for the upcoming school years (2018-2019) include moving to our new building located directly across from the first site; 5249 N. 35th Street. We are also officially opening Carter's Christian Wellness Center located directly next door at 5246

N. 35th Street. The vision of a CCA Campus is rapidly becoming a reality and we endeavor to build our community as well as the lives of our students. CCA is a perfect example of children from different walks of life growing together, learning together, working together while accepting and embracing people from all economic backgrounds and cultures.


