

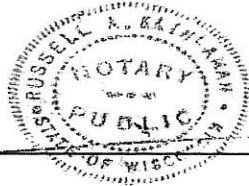

Pursuant to sec. 67.05(1), Stats., PLEASE TAKE NOTICE That the City of Milwaukee has adopted an initial resolution authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds in the amount of \$2,000,000 for the purpose or purposes hereinafter enumerated, which was recorded on February 27, 2018. PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that such initial resolution must be submitted to the electors under sec. 67.05(5), Stats., if within thirty (30) days after the recording thereon there shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk a petition requesting such submission signed by electors numbering at least ten (10%) percent of the votes cast for Governor in the City at the last general election, and that if such petition is filed, proceedings shall be had in accordance with sec. 67.05(5), Stats.

Substitute resolution authorizing the sale and issuance of general obligation bonds in the aggregate amount of \$2,000,000 for water systems.

Whereas, File 160742 provides for a city subsidy for the cost of replacing the privately-owned portion of lead service lines on properties meeting certain eligibility criteria, and the city desires to provide an additional \$2,000,000 of subsidies to meet the needs for properties in the city; and

Whereas, The 2017 budget of the city authorized \$200,000,000 of contingent borrowing, of which \$80,800,000 has been allocated for other purposes; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it hereby authorizes and declares its purpose to sell and issue general obligation bonds in the aggregate amount of \$2,000,000 for water systems; and, be it

Further Resolved, That \$2,000,000 of 2017 contingent borrowing is allocated for the additional water system debt; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the debt

may be issued as Bonds and/or Notes pursuant to resolution numbers 161128 and 161127 (including direct loan notes), and that such debt shall be a purpose of Contingent Borrowing - Unallocated in Exhibit A of the resolutions, including refunding of direct loan notes if the debt is temporarily issued as direct loan notes.
