I have a prior commitment for all-day meeting on Thursday, January 29, so I will not be able to attend the hearing on File #081322, titled "Resolution relating to the installation of a left-turn traffic signal at the intersection of North 107th Street and West Good Hope Road." However, I want to formally convey to you my support for the resolution. No matter how careful I am in attempting to make a left (west) turn from that intersection during peak hours, I have had some very close calls because of the extreme difficulty of seeing southbound traffic at a time when two or more vehicles, including large vans and trucks, are lined up to turn eastward from the southbound left turn lane.

As the coordinator of the Granville Heritage Neighborhood Association e-mail contacts, I have received more that a half-dozen complaints from neighbors about the hazards they have encountered in making that left-hand turn from the northbound left turn lane at that intersection. We are all concerned that we may have lives lost or bodies maimed unless a left-turn signal during peak hours is installed.
