This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/21/2018 at 11:40pm officers conducted a licensed premise check at Likkle Jamayka, 235 S 2<sup>nd</sup> St. based on a complaint they were operating without the proper licenses. The officers spoke with the applicant who was on scene. The applicant stated the business was operating as a restaurant but had a DJ on Thursday-Saturday nights. The business license had expired on 12/27/17 but a provisional was issued. The hours for the provisional were still the same as the original license, closing at 10:30pm on Sunday-Thursday and 11:30pm on Friday and Saturday nights. He stated he has security in place and was checking ID's at the door. On 03/22/2018 at 9:15pm the officers were dispatched back to check for license violations. When they arrived they found the front door locked but people inside. The applicant opened the side door and allowed the officers inside. He stated he was waiting for the DJ to arrive and kept the doors locked to keep the patrons out until the DJ was set up. The applicant stated he was advised he could operate during the times he requested in his new license. He was advised to not lock the door and could only operate during the hours listed on the provisional license until new hours were approved by the Common Council.

#### \* PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Thomas FRANK, assigned to District 1, Late Power shift. On Wednesday, March 21st, 2018, at 11:40PM, Sq. 1440 (PO Molly PLUMLEY & I), conducted a tavern check at the location of 235 S. 2nd St. (Likkle Jamayka). On 3/17/18, at 12:10PM, an anonymous caller requested officers conduct a tavern check on the premises as they were operating without being licensed properly (CAD #180761084). Sq. 1143 (PO Gregory GENIESSE) responded to the location, but the business was not open.

PO PLUMLEY and I arrived at the location and spoke to the agent who was on scene, Adriel O. MCFARLANE, B/M, 8/6/85. MCFARLANE was extremely cooperative while speaking with officers. MCFARLANE informed officers that the business was still operating as a restaurant, but there will be nightly entertainment in the form of a DJ, Thursday-Saturday nights going forward. Officers observed MCFARLANE'S licenses, which were framed and posted inside. The business was granted a provisional license, which was one of the licenses framed and posted. MCFARLANE expressed his desire to work closely with Neighborhood Services, and the Police Department to run a successful business, and prevent any negative incidents. MCFARLANE has cameras installed on the premises, which are monitoring but not currently recording. MCFARLANE stated he plans to get the cameras recording in the near future. MCFARLANE has security in place, which will be checking IDs at the door, conducting pat downs, and using a metal detection wand.

Later on that evening, 3/22/18, at 1:27AM, after PO PLUMLEY and I left the location, another call was made requesting officers conduct a tavern check for the same reason as listed above (CAD #180810142).

On 3/22/18, officers received information from City Hall stating that the licenses for this location expired 12/27/17 and they are currently operating under a provisional license. The approved hours for the provisional license are the same as those on the expired licenses (closing at 10:30PM, Sunday-Thursday, and 11:30PM Friday and Saturday). They did request a change of hours with their renewal applications, but that request will not be heard by the License Committee until 4/4/18. The operators were told they could not operate under the requested hours until approval by the Common Council.

PO PLUMLEY and I returned to the location on 3/22/18, at 9:15PM, where officers observed several individuals inside of the location, but found the front door to be locked from the inside. MCFARLANE was again present, and immediately opened the door and let officers in, through a side door. Officers advised MCFARLANE that he can under no circumstances be operating with the front door locked. MCFARLANE stated he was awaiting the DJ, and was just trying to keep any patrons out until the DJ arrived and set up.

MCFARLANE was advised of the information regarding the hour restriction of the provisional license, and that he did not have approval to operate during the times he requested until he meets with the Common Council on 4/4/18. MCFARLANE stated he was advised that he could, and that is why he had been staying open past the posted time. MCFARLANE stated he understood the hour restriction, and he would make sure he is not operating past the required time until he receives the proper approval.

In closing, the Milwaukee Police have been called to that location due to complaints from local residents. We had discussions with the police; they have been amazingly kind and helpful to us. We do not want more trouble and anxiety \$\in\$ & for the great tenants in the neighborhood.







Dear Licensing Committee,

I am writing to inform you of several concerns I have regarding an establishment in District 12, Likkle Jamayka, located at 235 S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and operated by Adriel McFarlane.

I feel I need

to remain anonymous because I currently do not trust the actions of this person or his associates. I hope you understand.

I am choosing to voice these concerns against Adriel McFarlane, the owner of Likkle Jamayka, because he recently applied to renew his liquor license, and it should be coming for review. before the License Committee in April. I feel strongly that Mr. McFarlane should NOT be allowed to continue to operate a business in this city and our neighborhood for the reasons outlined below.

While he was in business as Likkle Jamayka, Mr. McFarlane, mismanaged the business to an egregious level. Over the course of summer and into the fall of 2017, Mr. McFarlane did the following:

- Withheld credit/debit card tips from paychecks and kept them for himself
- Wrote paychecks with the knowledge they would bounce
- Denied final paychecks had no choice but to resign
- Did not pay state sales taxes (Department of Revenue case #2018TW000367)
- Did not file legal tax forms for unemployment insurance
- Accrued multiple vendor debts (see related Wisconsin court cases under his name and business name)

While reports have been filed with the Department of Workforce Development, I feel it is important that you are made aware of these offenses as someone who actively reviews license applications and renewals for business in your district.

Furthermore, while Mr. McFarlane has been able to reopen recently with a provisional renewal liquor license, he is currently operating under violations of his original license AND has falsified his license application. Per the Tavern/Bar Problems page of the City Clerk's Office web site, I believe Mr. McFarlane is in violation of:

Failure of the licensee to operate the premise in accordance with the floor plan and plan of operation submitted to the City as part of his or her license application.

- Likkle Jamayka is no longer functioning as a restaurant, the business phone number is disconnected the website no longer works and is listed as being closed on Yelp.
- It is, however, being rebranded on social media into a night club called "Lounge 235" which does not follow the original business plan and plan of operation the provisional license in which the city approved him to operate and is reviewing as part of his renewal.
  - LJ is currently approved to operate as a restaurant with occasional music acts and DJs, it is not approved to operate as a bottle service, VIP sectioned club with nightly DJs and dancing.
  - LJ is currently approved to open Mon Thu 10:30AM 10:30PM, and until

11:30PM on Friday and Saturday. HOWEVER, club promoter posts on social media continually show the club will be open much later both during the week and weekend:



Operation of the tavern in such a manner that it constitutes a nuisance or permitting conduct that has a substantial adverse effect on the health, safety or convenience and prosperity of the immediate neighborhood.


- Adriel has stated to people that he has a new partner and investor in his business to keep it afloat, yet Adriel appears nowhere in any of the new branding or communications. Rather, he has turned the business and property over to Jimmy Earl Simms, who has a past felony conviction, and who recently was evicted from another property and owes over \$10,000 for property destruction, etc. That case number is 2017SC040267 if you are interested.
- The crowd Jimmy Simms brings in is questionable to say the least. His other location, Court Side, is known for underage drinking. His instagram account @earljimmy and business account @courtside\_milwaukee give a good idea of what type of establishments this person runs.





The resurgence of so many forward-thinking businesses and residences in Walker's Point have made it one of the best places in Milwaukee to be. I'm appealing to you stewards of this neighborhood and city to help keep Adriel McFarlane, Jimmy Simms, their associates and Lounge 235 out of our community.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

Torres w/f 09-23-81 who stated that she was struck on back of her head by a known subject. Madeline stated that she was at Bamboo Lounge at 201 W. Mitchell St. with some friends. Madeline stated that she was told that a female subject that she had problems with in the past, had arrived at the Lounge. Madeline stated that Maria N. Torres w/f 09-01-87 had issues with her. Madeline stated that she had dated a male subject that apparently had being in a relationship with Maria. Madeline stated that she no longer is in a relationship with the gentlemen and Maria knows that. Madeline stated that on September 24, 2016 at the end of the night at Bamboo Lounge, Maria had grabbed her by the hair to start a fight. Madeline stated that security broke it up and Maria was escorted out of the place. Madeline stated that back on September, Maria had made threats to harm Madeline if she was to see her again. Madeline stated that she alerted security regarding Maria on 01-14-17. Madeline told security to escort Maria out because she knew that Maria was going to start problems. Madeline stated that she went to the bathroom with her friend Nichole T. Fields w/f 08-26-83. Madeline stated that she walked out of the bathroom and suddenly she was grabbed by her hair. Madeline stated that she looked back and it was Maria Torres. Madeline stated that Maria then struck her on back of her head with a glass bottle. Madeline stated that her and Nichole both slipped and fell to the floor. Madeline stated that security grabbed Maria and escorted her out. Madeline stated that she the exited the lounge and was driving home. Madeline stated that she felt her hair wet. Madeline stated that when she checked her hair and head, she observed blood. Madeline stated that she drove with Nichole to St. Francis Hospital. Madeline stated that she had a laceration on back of her head that required two staples and three stitches to close. Madeline stated that Maria was wearing a black shirt and black and white pants.

I spoke to Nichole who stated that she was with Madeline at Bamboo lounge on 01-14-17. Nichole stated that she was made aware that Maria Torres was in the club. Nichole stated that she knew that Maria was after Madeline and had made threats to harm Madeline in the past. Nichole stated that she was coming out of the bathroom with Madeline, when she observed Maria grabbing Madeline by the hair. Nichole stated that she then observed Maria striking Madeline over the head with a glass bottle. Nichole stated that her and Madeline then slipped and fell to the floor with the fluids that spilled out the bottle that Maria hit Madeline with. Nichole stated that she knows Maria from Facebook and had seeing her in the past when she attempted to fight Madeline back in September of 2016. Nichole stated that she would email me photos of Maria Torres and also the messages that she sent to Madeline via Facebook messenger. Nichole stated that Maria was wearing black shirt with black and white pants. Nichole stated that she then left with Madeline. Nichole stated that she observed that Madeline was bleeding from her head and they both went to St. Francis hospital.

I observed that Madeline had Two staples to her head and three stitches. I also read paper work from St. Francis Hospital that stated that about the medical treatment received. I received two electronic mails from Nichole T. Fields of Facebook photos of suspect and of Facebook messenger text messages between suspect and victim regarding the incident. Both electronic mails were printed and placed under Milwaukee inventory number 17001790. I went to Maria's last known address at 1110 S 29th St. in attempt to locate. I was not able to locate Maria N. Torres.


