REASON FOR REQUEST:

Michael Lees, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police squad car that was traveling eastbound on West Keefe Avenue. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of North 16th Street and West Keefe Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on West Keefe Avenue, failed to yield the right-of-way by turning left in front of the City Vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Lees sustained injuries to his neck, back, wrists, hand, and right knee. The treating physician indicated the cervical spine injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$35,702.24.
