To Whom It May Concern:

June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008 about 9:15pm my husband Michael pulled in to a gas station (27.5) and Edgerton) to run in and grab a bag of ice for our camping trip the next morning. He was in the gas station for about one minute when he saw his brake lights pulling away from the gas station. He then realized his 1999 Chevy Suburban was just stolen. He called 911 and within minutes the Milwaukee Police Department was on the scene. The gas station had surveillance that the police were able to rewind and watch. They saw the young male who was walking past the gas station at the time who had seen my husband get out of his truck. The young male then proceeded towards my husband's truck he jumped in and drove away. By around 9:30pm on June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008 my husband, Michael, had his 1999 forest green Chevy Suburban reported as a stolen vehicle.

I had to pick my husband up from the gas station and we were told we would get a call when the vehicle was found. Minutes seemed like hours and the longer the vehicle was gone the more my husband and I thought, that's it, they will never find it. I would have to say it was one of the longest nights of my life. All we kept thinking was how grateful we were that none of our five children were in the vehicle at the time or that my husband didn't get hurt.

June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008 about 8:30am we received a phone call from an officer letting us know he had recovered the vehicle (N. 7<sup>th</sup> St.). It had been in a high speed chase for about a mile and a half until it struck a tree and chase came to an end. We went to the

scene of the accident and noticed how much damage was done to our vehicle. The truck hit a tree with such force it actually snap the tree in half and the truck was on top of the tree. By the time we got there, the detectives all ready did there investigation. They had finger printed the entire truck. Black finger print dust covered our tan interior. There was so much I thought that the air bags deployed. They had taken several pictures of the scene and gave us some information about what had happened. They also gave us information about restitution and told us to make sure we go to his court date. The information we would need would come in the mail. My husband was able to drive off the tree and curb in four wheel drive. We decided then, that we would just drive the truck home instead of incurring more cost by it being towed.

August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008 we appeared in court to receive our restitution and to hear the young mans sentence. We were asking for \$8,200 in restitution. That would cover the cost to repair the truck and the stolen items that were taken out of the truck. Long story short he pretty much got a slap on the wrist and was only ordered to pay \$4,500 in restitution. \$4,500 doesn't even come close to the damages to our vehicle much less everything he had stolen from our vehicle. The reason he was only ordered to pay half of what we were asking was because he doesn't have enough cogitative skills to hold a job and/or keep a job. If he has enough skills to steal and drive a vehicle he should have enough skills to get a job. We were told from the DA not to expect to see anything in restitution.

August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008 we received a notice/bill from the violations bureau. It was a parking ticket that was put on my husband's vehicle on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 2:16am. This was about 5 hours after we had reported the vehicle stolen. To the current date we have

been fighting this parking ticket which is now up to \$45.00 and is in collection. We have given the violation bureau everything they have wanted, from police reports to stolen license plate report and they still say that the ticket is valid and payment is still due on our behalf. On a side note, I spoke to a woman at the violations bureau to clear up the ticket and she had told me that the ticket still stands because we supposedly reported the truck stolen after the ticket was placed. That's Funny? The truck was reported stolen on June 5<sup>th</sup> and the ticket was issued June 6<sup>th</sup>.

Our concern is how come the ticket was even put on my husband's vehicle that night? When the ticket was placed on our vehicle the parking checker employed by the DPW should have had some way to recognize that it was a stolen vehicle. It would have stopped a whole lot of trouble later that morning. There would have been no high speed chase and no damage to our vehicle and heck, all of our stolen items might have still been in the vehicle. I had spoken to Michael T. Simons, the parking citation review manager, who had told me he knows this, is a problem and Milwaukee County is trying to fix it.

So not only do we have a totaled vehicle, we need to replace the stolen items that were in it. The judge can't even hold the person who did it accountable and now Milwaukee County is holding us accountable for his parking ticket. Milwaukee County is negligent in this matter. Milwaukee County should be responsible for the damages to our vehicle and responsible for ruining our name by putting us in collection for a ticket that is not ours. What we would like to happen, is for the county to dismiss the parking ticket that is not ours, clear our name from collection, and cover the cost to repair the damages to our vehicle.
