
Dear Mr. Pringle:


We have received your claim in the amount of \$219.84, relating to damage to your vehicle's driver's side mirror that allegedly occurred during the towing of your vehicle.

Our investigation reveals that your 1997 Toyota Camry was towed to the City of Milwaukee Tow Lot on October 17, 2008 for being parked in a construction zone. The PT-27 Form that was completed prior to the towing of your vehicle noted it had pre-existing damage. The tow record also noted the towing contractor for the City indicated when they arrived to tow the car, a semi truck had struck your vehicle and the mirror in question had been damaged. Since the City followed proper procedures in this matter and it was not the cause of the damage to your vehicle, it cannot accept liability and we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
