

Dear Ms. Darty:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$431.50, relating to damage done by the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) on September 5, 2008 when they forced entry into your home at 3079 North 30<sup>th</sup> Street.

Our investigation reveals that the MPD came to this location to arrest Anthony Moton on two outstanding felony warrants. The responding officers observed Mr. Moton inside the home through a window. He refused to answer the door, the officers announced themselves and then forced entry into the home. Mr. Moton escaped the building before officers could take him into custody. The MPD followed standard procedures and were acting within their sphere of responsibility, thus the City would not be liable, as such, and we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
