Low-Income Housing For The Hamptons: East Long Island, NY, legendary as the home of the Hamptons, long a mecca for celebrities and wealth, has little room in the villages for low-income housing. That scarcity is about to ease. More than 200 hopefuls will vie in a lottery organized by the Town of Southampton for two new three-bedroom homes. The town donated the land and the Southampton Business Alliance Housing Initiative Corporation and the Southampton Business Alliance built the units. The Long Island Housing Partnership coordinated the application process and applicant qualification to buy a home. The homes will each sell for \$322,400 to the qualified lottery winners, a sales price considered affordable housing for an individual earning less than \$93,050.
