





- 2017 Onsite Clinic Visit Stats
  - Over 4,000 visits to workplace and injury prevention clinic
  - Average Onsite Clinic Visit Cost: \$85
  - Avoided Costs: \$1.5M
  - ROI is around 4:1
  - Current Clinic Space is maximized and no further room to add hours/staff
- DER has been actively looking for a second clinic location for over a year
  - Reached out to MHD, DPW, DCD and MPL but cannot find suitable location
- Workplace Clinic Specs
  - Clinic exam room minimum dimensions of 10.5 x 12.5 feet
  - Similar size area needed for registration/waiting space
  - Currently occupied city building that doesn't need extra staff or security to keep location open
  - Easily accessible to employees and spouses with available parking
  - Close to onsite accessible bathrooms
  - Clinic room capacity for a sink in the space or the ability to add one
  - Space that does not require a huge capital investment

### Workplace Clinic Expansion

- FastCare Clinics through Froedtert Workforce Health
  - Walk-in clinics similar to the City's Workplace Clinic, NOT urgent care
    - Provide care for adults and children with no appointment necessary
    - Clinic Visit Cost: \$59
  - Allows DER to expand clinic services immediately to dependents (6 yrs+)
    - Dependents would only be seen at FastCare not Workplace Clinic
  - Expanded Clinic Hours including Evening and Weekends—FastCare Only
    - Weekdays: 9am 8:30pm
    - Weekends: Saturday 9am 6pm and Sunday 10am 5pm
  - Treat the following conditions (Age restrictions apply for selected services)
    - Allergies, Bladder infections (females 12 yrs and older), Cold and flu symptoms, Cold sores, Ear infections, Impetigo, Insect bites, Laryngitis, Minor burns, Mononucleosis, Musculoskeletal aches and strains, Nebulizer treatments (Albuterol), Pink eye, Poison ivy, Physicals (camp, school, sport), Rashes, Ringworm, Sinus infections, Sore throat, Sunburn, Swimmer's ear, Upper respiratory infections
  - Lab services available: Influenza, Mononucleosis test, Pregnancy test, Rapid strep, Urinalysis, TB



### Workplace Clinic Expansion

- FastCare Clinic Locations
  - FastCare (McKinley Health Center—downtown Milwaukee)
  - FastCare (Greenfield Meijer)
  - FastCare (Waukesha Meijer)
  - FastCare (West Bend Meijer)
  - FastCare (Sussex Meijer)
- Pilot Program for employees, spouses, dependents (ages 6+) with City's UHC health insurance
  - Will have to show UHC insurance card at FastCare Clinics to receive care
- Requires amendment with current Froedtert Workforce Health contract
