Suicide Prevention Gatekeeper Training

Just as people trained in CPR and the Heimlich Maneuver help save thousands of lives each year, people trained in QPR learn how to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade, and refer someone to help

Motivational Interviewing

Alma Institute

- Help people resolve ambivalent feelings and insecurities to find the internal motivation they need to change their behavior
- Practical, empathetic, and short-term process that takes into consideration how difficult it is to make life changes

Youth Mental Health First Aid

Teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help an adolescent who is experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or is in crisis

Drug Identification Training for Education **Professionals**

- Teach school staff, nurses and youth workers to
 - recognize when a student is under the influence
 - recognize drug paraphernalia
