If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer KUKOWSKI, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/27/2017 officers were dispatched to the Clark gas station at 1418 S Muskego Av to investigate a battery complaint. The officers spoke to the employee, Juan RODRIGUEZ, who stated a subject he had confronted earlier in the day about shoplifting. At about 11:45pm the subject returned with two other subjects. He was struck in the face by the actors who then fled on foot.
- 2. On 02/16/17 at 10:26 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1418 S Muskego Avenue for a altered currency complaint. The caller informed police that he received a counterfeit ten dollar bill from the store employee, Imran Javed, when he received change from his purchase. The victim turned over the counterfeit currency to police.
- 3. On 05/10/17 at 11:35 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1418 S Muskego for a subject with gun complaint. Police spoke with the clerk, identified as Imran Javed, who stated that two unknown females walked into the gas station and requested to use the bathroom. Javed stated he told the women that the bathroom was unavailable at this time and both females got upset. After a brief argument, a third female walked into the gas station when she retrieved a small semi-automatic from her waist and directed it towards Javed and threatened to shoot him. Javed fearing for his safety, ran behind his co-worker who was standing nearby. The female subject continued to point her gun at both men when one of them called police. Officers viewed surveillance video and the female was identified and later arrested.

- 4. On 05/20/17 at 3:51 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1418 S Muskego for a Subject with weapon complaint. Police spoke with the clerk, Imran Javed, who stated a male was armed with a knife and was standing in front of his business creating a disturbance and fear to his customers. Officers viewed surveillance video that showed the man armed and approaching customers. It also showed the subject to have jumped on a car that was parked in front of the business and stabbed the vehicle with the knife. The subject was disarmed and officers found 2 knives in the rear of the business. Subject was later arrested.
- 5. On 06/12/17 at 7:21 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1418 S Muskego for a sick and injured complaint. Investigation found a subject had ingested heroin at the location and was being treated by MFD who was on scene. The subject was later arrested for an unrelated incident.
- 6. On 12/15/17 at 3:22 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1418 S Muskego for a battery complaint. Officers spoke with the clerk Imran Javed who stated a female was in the business and she made a food and gas purchase and paid with a credit card. The female didn't pump the amount she paid in gas and requested a cash refund. Javed stated he couldn't give her cash, but would refund the amount on her credit card. The woman became loud and disruptive and began grabbing bags of chips and other snacks. Javed stated he approached the woman and took back the property before the woman could leave. The woman then pushed him and struck him several times to his head and face, breaking his glasses. The female exited the store and knocked over garbage cans near the gas pump before getting in her auto and fleeing. Police viewed surveillance and obtained the plate which listed to the subject and she was issued citations for assault & battery and disorderly conduct.

This report is submitted by P.O. Mariolys FLORES, assigned to District Two, Late-Power shift. On Wednesday, May 10, 2017 at 11:35 p.m., Squad 2450 (P.O. Richard TOLENTINO and I) responded to a subject with gun complaint at (Clark gas station) 1418 S Muskego Av Located in the City and County of Milwaukee state of WI. Upon arrival we spoke to the victim Imran JAVED (A/M, 7/8/83), gas station clerk, who stated that two unknown females walked into the gas station and requested to use the bathroom. JAVED stated that he told both unknown females that the bathroom was unavailable at this time and both females got upset. After a brief verbal argument a third female later identified as Jamila M. ALI (H/F 4/26/92) walks inside the gas station with the other two females. ALI then retrieved a small semi-automatic handgun from her waist and directed it towards JAVED and threatens to shoot him. JAVED fearing for his safety ran behind his coworker who was standing nearby identified as Khan ZAMAN (A/M, 8/18/64). ALI continued to point her hand gun towards both JAVED and ZAMAN. ZAMAN quickly got on his phone and called police. ALI and the other two females left the scene. After reviewing surveillance video an assisting squad 2271 (Paul SZYMBORSKI and Jason G WARWICK) identified the subject with the gun to be ALI. A DOT check of ALI gave us her last known address of 2673 S 14th St. Upon arrival to ALI's house; ALI was placed under arrest and conveyed to District Two for processing.

This report was written by PO Ester KREMSEROVA, assigned to District 2, Late Power Shift.

On Saturday, May 20, 2017 at 3:51 am, while assigned to Squad 2350, I was dispatched to a subject with a weapon complaint at 1418 S Muskego Av, in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI. Dispatched location is a Clark's gas station.

Upon arrival, I spoke to Imran JAVED (w/m, 7/8/1983), who was a clerk at the location. JAVED directed me towards the suspect, later identified as Osvaldo MENDOZA-BAROCIO (w/m, 11/28/1988).

On the listed date at approximately 3:45 am, MENDOZA-BAROCIO loitered in front of and inside of the business, possessed a knife visible to public, created disturbance and fear, causing the Police to respond.

Sgt. MANHKE viewed surveillance video of the alleged incident. Video showed MENDOZA-BAROCIO on the listed date and at approximately 3:45 am outside and in front of the business with a knife in his right hand. MENDOZA-BAROCIO got on top of an unknown, tan in color vehicle, parked in front of the location. MENDOZA-BAROCIO appeared to stab the vehicle with the knife. Video showed MENDOZA-BAROCIO approaching customers visiting the business. MENDOZA-BAROCIO then entered the location and appeared to wave the knife around as he continued to approach customers. COLON-LOPEZ then approached MENDOZA-BAROCIO and grabbed the knife from him and exited the location.

Sgt. MANHKE canvassed the exterior area and located 2 knives in the grass, in the rear of the business, one of which matched the knife seen on the surveillance video.

MENDOZA-BAROCIO was arrested.

While on scene, I did not observed any visible violations and JAVED was cooperative.

A sick/injured report was filed.



#### PA-33E Narrative

This report was written by PO Vance SCOLLIN, District Two, Early Shift. On 12-15-17 at approximately 5:22 PM, while assigned to Sqd 2226 (uniformed bicycle patrol with PO SZYMBORSKI), we were dispatched to a battery complaint at Clark Gas Station, 1418 S Muskego Av. Upon arrival, I spoke to the clerk who I identified as Imran JAVED (w/m 7-8-83 1418 S Muskego Av, 645-6426). JAVED stated a black female was in the business and she purchased a beverage and some chips for \$3.00 and \$20 in gas. JAVED stated the female paid with a credit card inside at approximately 5:10 PM. JAVED stated the female exited the business and she pumped \$15.62 in gas on pump number two into the fuel tank of a black GMC Envoy (WI plate 202ZFP). JAVED stated the female then came back inside at approximately 5:18 PM and requested a cash refund for the difference between \$20 and \$15.62. JAVED stated he explained to the female that this was not possible and the difference would automatically be put back on her card. JAVED stated the female became loud and disruptive in the business and began grabbing bags of chips and other snacks and she stated she was taking these items since they would not refund her the cash. JAVED stated he approached the female and took back the items before the female could leave and she pushed him near the main doors of the business and she then struck him several times on his head and face causing pain. JAVED's eye glasses were broken due to the assault and he also stated his left hand was injured. A check of the GMC's registration plate revealed that it was registered to Kimberly A SUPER (b/f 8-16-85, 1202 S 65th St West Allis, WI 53214). I then obtained a photo of SUPER in the Milwaukee Police Department's booking system and I confirmed that she was the subject who assaulted JAVED. I will be attempting to make contact with SUPER at her residence to issue her a citation for assault and battery and disorderly conduct. I did not observe any violations regarding this business while I was on scene.



Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

### Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

On Thursday, November 23rd, 2017, at approximately 2:20 AM, I was informed by PO Matthew DAVIS that he observed several subjects enter 1619 S. 1st Street., which is the Point's View Boite, after 2:00 AM, which is the established time for bar closing in Milwaukee on Thursdays. PO DAVIS said he also observed a large group of subjects inside the establishment standing at the bar and consuming beverages after 2:00 AM on Thursday, the 23rd.

I arrived at 2:25 AM and attempted to enter the main (east) entrance door and was temporarily blocked by the security at the door. The security told me no one else was allowed to enter. I informed him I was a Police Officer and he apologized, saying he didn't immediately recognize me.

I observed a large group of subjects inside the establishment and would later count them and discover approximately forty patrons were inside the establishment. I did not do an exact count; I counted those seated at the bar and those consuming alcoholic beverages. I observed one bartender behind the bar moving quickly from patron to patron as he accepted currency and served each one. I stopped my count at forty as I began to speak with the owner and licensee, identified as Marcos RAMOS-GARCIA.

RAMOS-GARCIA said he believed bar close was at 2:30 AM on Holidays, to include Thanksgiving, New Years, and Christmas. RAMOS-GARCIA explained he is a new business owner, and is not familiar with all the rules. I informed him I know bar close to be 2:00 AM on Thanksgiving.

RAMOS-GARCIA was cooperative and apologetic. RAMOS-GARCIA said if he was incorrect about closing on Thanksgiving it would not happen again. RAMOS-GARCIA expressed his interest in maintaining his establishment as a safe business in compliance with tavern regulations.

This report is written by PO Benjamin SPITZER, District Two, Late Power.

On Saturday, March 31st, 2018 at approximately 2:41AM while assigned to SQ 2464 (PO Matthew SCOTT and I) conducted a tavern check at 1619 S. 1st St, Points View Boite.

While monitoring bar close in the Walker's Point area I observed a large amount of patrons within the Points View Boite. We then conducted a tavern check at the listed tavern regarding the observed violation. Upon making entry to the business the security had the door locked. Security opened the door, and upon entering the location the bartenders immediately began to yell it's time to go, and everyone has to go. I observed a large quantity of patrons at the bar still consuming beverages, and several bartenders behind the counter.

All patrons exited the business through the front door. PO Gregory KNOX (SQ 2490) was at the rear exit to the business, and did not observe any patrons leave through the rear exit. PO SCOTT and I each counted the number of patrons who exited the tavern. We both counted sixteen (16) patrons who exited the tavern approximately fifteen minutes past bar close. It should be noted that it only took approximately two to three minutes for the patrons to clear out.

I spoke with the owner, identified as Marcos A. RAMOS-GARCIA (W/M, 03-01-85), who stated that they had a very busy night. RAMOS-GARCIA stated that they were having a difficult time closing patron's bar tabs and getting people out of the business. I advised RAMOS-GARCIA that he should have done last call at a sooner time to ensure all patrons were out past bar close. I also advised RAMOS-GARCIA that his excuse was unsatisfactory due to the fact it only took a few minutes to get the remaining patrons out of the tavern once we entered the business. I advised RAMOS-GARCIA he could receive a citation for this incident, and that District Two would be in contact with him to set up a meeting regarding this matter.


