Your Public Entertainment Premises, Extended Hours Establishments, Food Dealer, Filling Station, and Weights & Measures License Renewal Applications as agent for "Villard Pump & Pantry Inc" for "Villard Pump & Pantry" at 4105 W Villard Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more commendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Denise Rueda assigned to the License Investigation Unit. On Saturday, August 26, 2017, I was assigned to work the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, checking area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. Assisting in this assignment was Maya RANDOLPH, (B/F, 04/17/01), of 1329A N. 43RD Street. RANDOLPH is 16 years of age which is not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 11:30am, RANDOLPH entered Villard Pump & Pantry at 4105 W Villard Avenue and purchased 1-pk of 2/\$.99 Swisher Sweets cigars. RANDOLPH stated the cashier/clerk described as a Middle Eastern male with black short hair wearing a blue shirt never asked her (RANDOLPH) for an ID. I entered the store and immediately identified the cashier based on the description given. The cashier identified himself as Vasim KHUDARATHULLAH (A/M, 10/04/85) did remember RANDOLPH and did admit to selling RANDOLPH Swisher Sweet cigars without asking her for her ID. KHUDARATHULLAH was advised that I would be sending out a letter to enroll in the M.A.R.T.S. program.

The listed agent/defendant Lokesh DASARI did enrolled in the municipal citation diversion program "Marts" (Milwaukee Achieving Responsible Tobacco Sales) and failed the mystery shopper inspection on December 3, 2017. As such is now being cited for the underlying violation of sale of cigarettes to a minor/underage.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
