I hope this email finds you well. My name is Lee Valentyn and I am a resident and homeowner on the 1000-block of S 24th Street. It was brought to my attention that a property near my house, the building at 2637 W Greenfield Avenue, may be torn down in favor of playground/parking lot space at the North Dame middle school campus on that block.

I am open to hearing the school's plans for this space, but I also understand that this property is part of the historic district on Layton Boulevard and has a rich history in the community. I encourage the Historic Preservation Commission to designate this building as "historic" and protect it, at least temporarily, from plans calling for its removal before it can be determined whether the building should be designated historic on a permanent basis. I would also call for the school to engage the community in their plans for the development of the property.
