This letter is to inform you that the above matter was approved at the Historic Preservation Commission meeting of May 16, 2018 as the building meets the criteria of s. 320-21-3-e-5 and e-9. Section e-5 relates to a building's embodiment of distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type or specimen and e-9 relates to a building's unique location which represents an established or familiar visual feature of a neighborhood, community or the city.

This designation is in effect for 180 days and within that time period a hearing will be held on the permanent historic designation. You will both be notified of this meeting and have a chance to testify.
