- Placed workers are from 30 different zip codes.
- A partnership with Central City Church Coalition has been established to help with assessing, counseling, and referring qualified candidates for training and employment.
- Orientations are held monthly to streamline enrollment.
- Contractors encouraged to attend orientations and assessments to screen candidates for training classes which exposes program participants to employers and their expectations.

Youth - Multi-Craft Core Curriculum Training

- 26 Milwaukee Public School Students participated in the MC3 Training held at MATC over the Summer 2017:
 - 19 students received a Certificate of Participation
 - Other Certificates attained during training:
 - √ 10 attained CPR Certification
 - √ 7 attained First Aid Certification
 - √ 7 attained OSHA 10 certification
 - ✓ 6 attained 1 MATC Math Course credit
 - ✓ 1 attained the MC3 Certification







Youth - Multi-Craft Core Curriculum Training

- 31 Milwaukee Public School Students from Bradley Tech and South Division started MC3 Training held at Bradley Tech:
 - Class started January 3rd and is being held during classroom hours, allowing for dual MPS and MATC credit.

Curriculum includes:

- ✓ CPR Certification
- ✓ First Aid Certification
- ✓ OSHA 10 certification
- ✓ Construction Math and Blueprint courses
- 15 students received an MC3 certificate, and 4 students received a certificate of participation.





Adult - Multi-Craft Core Curriculum Training

- 11 adults participated in the MC3 Training held at MATC during fall:
 - Class started November 27th and ran through December 22nd.
 - 10 individuals completed class and earned their MC3 credential.
- 17 adults participated in the MC3 training held at MATC during spring:
 - Class started March 19th and ran through May 1st at MATC.
 - 11 individuals completed class and earned their MC3 credential.
