Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney D. Michael Guerin for attorney's fees for representing Police Sergeant Carmello Patti. The claim is in the amount of \$1,875.00 for 7.50 hours of service billed at the rate of \$250 per hour, but should be in the amount of \$1,312.50, billed at the previously-set rate of \$175 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. A criminal investigation was initiated against the police officer on whose behalf this claim was filed, but he was ultimately not charged.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part as this matter did not result in "criminal proceedings." Wis. Stat. § 895.35(2)(a)1., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Carmello Patti is a Milwaukee Police Sergeant. On October 3, 2012 a mentally ill person Brandon Johnson died after being detained and transported to Mental Health Center by Milwaukee Police Officers from his home at 4486 North 55th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

There was a criminal investigation begun to determine if Sergeant Patti or any of the police officers involved, engaged in any criminal actions.

Sergeant Patti was required to meet with the criminal investigator on October 9, 2012 at the Milwaukee Police Training Academy.

Consistent with its ethical obligation and the policy, the City Attorney's office was unable to represent Sergeant Patti in this matter.

I am enclosing the printout of time at the hourly rate of \$250.00 an hour for services rendered regarding Stephen Hoffman. Sergeant Hoffman has incurred the fees complied in these printouts as a direct result of his being investigated for actions taken within his official capacity, and in the performance of his duties, in connection with the use of force. None of the "exceptions" to mandatory payment under § 895.35(2) Stats. apply. Therefore this investigation qualifies as a "proceeding" which mandates payment under § 895.35(2) Stats.
