Dear Mr. Westmoreland:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$2,790.00, relating to damage allegedly sustained in June 2008 when backwater from the City's sewer backed up into your residence at 4978 North 58<sup>th</sup> Street.

Our investigation reveals that this claim was filed on March 9, 2009. Wisconsin Statute §893.80 (1) (a) requires that a claim must be filed within 120 days after the happening of the event giving rise to the claim. This claim was not timely filed. In addition, the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate that because of the large amount and strong intensity of the rain during the weekend of June 6, 2008, the City experienced flows that exceeded the capacity of the sewer systems. The City checked the sewer main as a result of this claim and found it to be improper working order. The City was not negligent in this matter. As such, the City would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.
