Dear Council Members:

As required by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the City of Milwaukee is planning to perform Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCB) removal from City-owned sewers in the area of North Humboldt Avenue and East Capital Drive. The Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewage District (MMSD) also needs to perform PCB removal from district owned sewers in the same area. An Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement was proposed to add the City's work to the MMSD contract and the costs associated with the PCB removal from city sewers will be reimbursed to MMSD by the City. We have prepared the attached resolution directing the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with MMSD allowing them to add the City's PCB cleanup work to their contract.

We recommend adoption of the attached resolution.
