#### **Program Goals**

The Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) will provide grant funds to STAC to hire a new IP Analyst. The IP Analyst will be tasked with coordinating and developing infrastructure protection products and intelligence with our private partners (fusion liaison officer program) as well as other law enforcement agencies (task force officer program). Additionally, the IP Analyst will provide outreach to the 18 federally recognized critical sectors, and assist in the production and dissemination of Intelligence to STAC partners.

## **Programmatic Summary**

The purpose of the fiscal year 2017 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) is to support state and local efforts to prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events and to prepare the nation for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of the United States. The HSGP provides funding to implement investments that build, sustain, and deliver 32 core capabilities essential to achieving the National Preparedness Goal of a secure and resilient nation.

STAC is one of 79 fusion centers recognized by the United States Department of Homeland Security and is collocated with the Milwaukee Police Department's Intelligence Fusion Center. STAC provides a platform for collaboration among multiple federal, state, local and tribal agencies and disciplines to exchange information and intelligence, with the goal to improve the ability to detect, prevent, deter, and respond to crime and terrorism by analyzing data from various sources.
