This partnership was created with the intent of bringing together a multi-jurisdictional Traffic Safety Task Force geared towards a High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) effort focused on decreasing speed and aggressive driving violations, operating while intoxicated/impaired, and occupant restraint violations. The main purpose of this grant is for the enforcement of speeding and operating under the influence by motor vehicle operators.
