1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The 2019 Urban Forestry grant will establish an above-ground container tree growing system at the Municipal Nursery located in Franklin, WI to build capacity and provide greater flexibility and diversity in street tree stock. An above-ground container tree growing system increases the Nursery's capacity to meet demand for additional street tree replacements. Container tree stock provides flexibility in planting operations as the window for street tree planting is longer than bare root trees typically harvested at the Nursery. In addition, container trees allows for a greater diversity of tree species which will improve resiliency of the street tree population to invasive insects and diseases.

Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives: The 2019 Urban Forestry grant supports the goal of increased tree canopy and improved resiliency to climate change and other environmental threats/stressors. The street tree replacement diversification standard is an adaptation tool which requires a minimum of 4 different tree species planted per block to reduce transmission of pest infestation and disease and protect and restore tree canopy.
