ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

The applicant currently sells glass tire gauges, which are used for smoking crack cocaine, which I explained are used for making crack pipes. They also sell Chore Boy single use, which I explained is used for making crack pipes. After explaining the uses of the items,the applicant stated he would no longer sell them. Upon observing the store merchandise, I saw that the applicant sells numerous glass pipes, grinders, glass bongs, and other smoking devices, commonly used for smoking marijuana. I also provided the applicant with information to attend Robbery Prevention Training, which he stated that he hasn't attended in several years.



This report is written by PO Penny Brown assigned to the License Investigation Unit.

On Saturday, November 11, 2017, I was assigned to work Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, which checks area vendors for age compliant tobacco sales. Assisting in this assignment were: Tierra R. POLE B/F 11/8/00 5663 N. 95th St. Milwaukee 53225 and Josiah SCHMEISSER-DELOACHE B/M 10/12/01 2720 S. 13th St. Milwaukee 53215. POLE is 17 years old and SCHMEISSER-DELOACHE is 16 years old. Both are not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 10:50A, SCHMEISSER and POLE entered Time Food Mart, located at 1835 S. 25th St. and purchased a 2 pack Swisher Boozy Mango flavor cigars from the cashier described as A/M 20's with a full beard. POLE stated the cashier checked her id, however, still sold the tobacco to SCHMEISSER. I entered the store and identified the cashier based on the description. The cashier was identified as: Odai N. ASSAD A/M 6/27/92. ASSAD admitted to the sale and apologized. I explained I will be mailing out a MARTS enrollment packet to the agent.




