There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Applicant appeared knowledgeable on proper bar operation. She has bartended for the past 20-30 years, and use to bartend at this location under the old owner. City of Milwaukee BART # 0225171. She appears to want to change the image and operation of this estabishment to deter problems. The owner of the building installed a total of 6 cameras: two on the inside and four on the outside. Applicant wants building owner to install one more camera inside for extra coverage at the front door. I advised applicant to post no loitering signs on the exterior. There are two window that are glass block, which obstruct the outside view. Applicant will remove these glass block windows so she and her employees can be seen from the outside. Applicant was advised that lighting needs to be updated and new bulbs installed.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

The following incidents occurred under the current licensee Melissa Zanzig however Howard Zanzig, who is now applying as the licensee, is a corporate officer and was the bartender on scene when these incidents occurred.

1. On 11/09/09 at 1:47 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 8th and Becher for a Fight complaint. Investigation found two victims who were at Parks tavern got into a fight with some other patrons who struck them with pool sticks. One victim was struck to his forehead and needed stitches to close the laceration. While investigating, officers observed a rear emergency door with no lighting and found that door to be locked. Police spoke to the bartender Howard Zanzig who stated that he was in the process of closing the bar and that's why the lights were turned off. Attempts to contact the licensee Melissa Zanzig were unsuccessful and officers left a voice message for Melissa to contact them. It should be noted that Howard Zanzig did not notify police regarding this incident. Melissa Zanzig was cited for Licensed Premises-Safe Egress Required and Licensed Premises-Open Entry Required.

On 01/03/10 at 9:30 pm, Milwaukee police received information from a confidential informant that a subject knows as "Dano" works as a bartender at Park Shadows and would have cocaine on his person. Because of prior drug investigations, officers' known "Dano" to be Daniel Zanzig and found that there were open warrants for his arrest. Officers conducted a license premise check and found "Dano" and placed him under arrest. During a custodial search, officers recovered a folded up piece of white paper that contained a white powdery substance. Tests conducted at the district station confirmed this substance to be cocaine. Daniel Zanzig was charged with POCS WITD-Cocaine.

Item # 1 previously reported, disposition now added on 01/03/11.

3. On 03/25/10 at 12:09 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2079 S Becher Street for an Armed Robbery complaint. Investigation revealed a patron took approximately one dollar and seven quarters from the bar that another patron had sitting on the counter. The suspected patron was later found and a citation was issued to him for theft.


- 4. On 12/23/11 at 11:43 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Fight at 2079 S 8th Street. Officers spoke with the bartender, Christy Torres, who stated there was a verbal altercation inside the bar between a male and female with the female leaving the bar shortly after. The female returned shortly and the argument started up again, only to have the female leave and return shortly after with several other subjects who began causing a disturbance with bar patrons. A physical fight started with one patron getting hit in the head with a bottle causing an injury. Bar employees' removed all parties involved in the fight to the outside when some subjects began to break out the window of the front door and side window on the east side of the bar. Police found that no security guards were on duty at the time of this incident. The patron injured in the fight sought medical attention and did not want to prosecute. Report was filed.
- 5. On 03/08/13 at 11:15 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2709 S 8th Street for a Subject With Gun complaint. Investigation found a patron was inside the bar with her daughter when two males and three females entered the bar and started to argue with the bartender. These same subjects then called the patron's daughter a bitch and one of the male subjects punched the daughter in the face. No gun was observed or implied, the patron just felt that these types of people were likely to possess a gun. Police spoke with the bartender Deanna Konieczny, who stated a female entered the bar around 11 pm and that Konieczny asked for ID. The female refused and left the bar. A few minutes later the female returned with two males and two females, when one of the males attempted to give all their ID's to Konieczny at one time. Konieczny stated she determined that two of the subjects were underage and refused to serve them. Konieczny stated that is when one of the subjects began to argue with her. One of her patrons then told the subjects to just leave when one of the male subjects walked called the patron a bitch and punched her. Konieczny also stated that she did not see anyone with a firearm. Police notified the agent, Howard Zanzig regarding the incident.

6. On 12/14/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 2079 South 8th Street. The victim states he was involved in an argument with another patron while at the bar. This argument continued outside where the suspect struck and kicked the victim. Milwaukee police incident report #143480161 filed.

- 7. On 01/28/2016 Milwaukee police responded to an armed robbery complaint at 2079 South 8th Street (Park Place Sports Bar). Investigation revealed an unknown subject robbed the business at gunpoint. Milwaukee police incident report # 160280015 filed.
- 8. On 03/02/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 2503 South 7th Street. The caller, Gina Ford, told officers she was at Park Place Sports Bar (2079 South 8th Street) when an unknown female struck her in the face. Ford stated the bartender would not call 911, even though Ford asked her to several times. The officer then spoke to the bartender, Debi Damron, who stated she did not call police because she was trying to deescalate the situation, she did not see anyone get hurt, and she saw Ford call 911. Milwaukee police incident report # 160622528 filed.
- 9. On 03/10/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a shots fired complaint at 2079 South 8th Street (Park Place Sports Bar). The bartender, Debi Damron, told officers she had closed the bar around 2:00am and that she was the only person left in the business, when glass struck her in the face. Damron dove to the floor and heard 5-6 gunshots. Officers recovered 7 casings from the west side of the building. Milwaukee police incident report # 160700012 filed.

- 10. On 04/07/2017 officers investigated a burglary at Park Place Sports Bar, 2079 S 8th St. The bar was closed at the time of the incident.
- 11. On 08/20/2017 at 1:52am officers investigated shooting which occurred at S. 8th St and W. Becher St. The investigation revealed an argument began inside QuisQuilla Bar, 2078 S 8th St. Security pushed the parties outside, where the fight continued. A short time later a subject fired a gun. After the gun shot a group of patrons exited Park Place Sports Bar, 2079 S 8th St. The two groups had an interaction and an unknown subject fired a gun causing an exchange of gunfire. One of the patrons from Park Place was killed and a patron of QuisQuella Bar was struck in the chest. Park Place Sports Bar, a residence and several cars were struck by bullets. Officers recovered 83 casings from 6 different guns. The applicant arrived later and advised the video surveillance at Park Place was not recording. The bartender, Deanna ZONIECZNY, was cooperative stating she usually closes early to avoid problems with QuisQuella Bar.
- 12. On 09/08/2017 there was a meeting at District 2 regarding the shooting on 08/20/2017. Present were the applicant and the licensee from Quisquella Bar. Discussed were issues related to the two bars. It was suggested that different smoking areas be used so the patrons do not stand across from each other. It was also suggested to stager closing times to avoid conflict. Both parties were advised of the "Tavern Car" and to be proactive in handling of issues.
- 13. On 10/26/2017 officers along with an agent from the State Department of Revenue conducted a license premise check at Park Place Sports Bar, 2079 S 8th St. The officers found the licenses not posted in public view and liquor purchased at a retail outlet.

14. On 03/17/2018 at 1:00am officers were dispatched to Park Place Sports Bar, 2079 S 8th St, for a noise nuisance. Upon arrival the officers heard loud music coming from inside. The bartender stated they were having karaoke night. The officers advised her to turn it down.



- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.






3. On 11/14/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 828 South 1st Street (Desperados) based on Aldermanic complaints of patrons having sex and breaking bottles in the parking lot. Officers spoke to the applicant who stated he was aware of the complaints and had hired additional security to monitor the parking lot. He stated the activities have since ceased. No violations were observed.

4. On 04/30/2017 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight at 828 South 1st Street. The victim had numerous injuries on his face but refused medical attention. Another party told officers that the victim was attacked by three subjects as he left the bar. Milwaukee police incident report #171200016 filed.

11. On 01/20/2018 officers worked the special event, Fresh Empire, at VIP Lounge, 828 S 1st St. The event is a tobacco-free DJ event for children aged 13-17 with approximately 250-300 patrons. The event security is Midwest Intelligency Agency, who provides interior and exterior security. The security also assists at closing time to clear additional businesses where patrons of the event go after closing.

- 12. On 02/23/2018 officers conducted a licensed premises check at VIP Lounge, 828 S 1st St. The business was closed but the applicant was on scene and allowed the officers inside. The officers located 13 bottles contaminated with fruit flies and 12 bottles missing labels. WI Department of Revenue Agents seized 18 boxes of hookah tobacco, which the applicant says he supplies free to patrons. The applicant does not have a Tobacco License. The agents also seized 100 bottles of beer and 62 bottles of liquor that were not purchased from a distributor.
- 13. On 03/24/2018 officers responded to VIP Lounge, 828 S 1st St, to assist with a large crowd exiting the Fresh Empire event. The officer observed 100 people standing in the street and 200 on the sidewalk. When the subjects walked to surrounding businesses they walked in the roadway affecting traffic. The organizer Travis CHAMBERS stated there was a fight inside between two females. CHAMBERS had security empty the building. Several fights then occurred outside. He stated he gives away 1,500 tickets but only allows 300 inside. There were several calls for service regarding patrons from Fresh Empire. There were 2 arrests for Disorderly Conduct and 2 arrests for Resisting or Obstructing an Officer.

This report is submitted by P.O. Mariolys FLORES, assigned to District Two, Late-Power shift.

On Friday, July 28, 2017 at approximately 12:45 a.m. District two personnel performed a tavern check at Desperados located at 828 S 1st St for report of "dancers" being in the tavern which is in violation of their license. Sgt. Christopher Martin along with P.O. Taylor BAAS, P.O. David CABRAL, P.O. James COLLINS, P.O. Eulia KAZACHENKO and I entered the premises from the main entrance on S 1st St.

Upon entrance I spoke with Haffid A. FUENTES, (H/M, 11/21/79). At first he stated he was a bartender helping out with the private party that was taking place. Once I asked for license information, FUENTES stated that he was going to get the owner of Desperados so he can talk to me and walked away. Few minutes later FUENTES return and stated that the owner would be with me soon. Once I asked FUENTES for his bartender license, he stated that he was not a bartender and had not served anyone any alcoholic beverage and was just there to help out with other things.

I then spoke with the owner Miguel A. MARTINEZ (H/M, 1/22/79). MARTINEZ pointed out their license B tavern which was located on the wall next to the bar. MARTINEZ stated that someone had rented the premises for a private party.

Sgt. Martin spoke with MARTINEZ regarding the private party and dancers. During their conversation MARTINEZ confirmed to Sgt. MARTIN that Desperados was rented out for a private party at \$1,000 and that he was aware of the females dancing in lingerie for money and admitted that they were strippers. MARTINEZ stated that he did not have the proper permit to have such dancer at the premises and did nothing to stop such actions. His statement was recorded on P.O. Collins department's body worn camera.

It was noted that the party was not a private party due to the premises not being closed and people were being let inside.

I then spoke with Antonio TAPIA RODRIGUEZ, (H/M, 5/30/88), the bartender. I asked for his identification card and his bartending license TAPIA RODRIGUEZ stated he had to go to his car to retrieve his wallet. Once outside TAPIA RODRIGUEZ showed me his ID and his valid bartender license. I asked whose party was it inside the premises and TAPIA RODRIGUEZ stated that he was not sure. TAPIA RODRIGUEZ stated he has been working at Desperados for a few years and he gets called whenever he is needed.

As I return back inside the premises, I observed a couple of females standing by a few men at the bar wearing very revealing lingerie. As I made my way through the bar area towards the dance floor I observed two unknown males with hands full of money in hand and single dollar bills on the floor near their feet. As I continued to make my towards the kitchen northeast corner of the building, I observed a private area blocked out and being use as a changing room for the dancers in the building. In that room I observed a rack with different bright colored lingerie hanging on there. I also observed an unknown female sitting at a couch counting money and numerous dancers changing into casual attire.

- P.O. Cabral spoke to one of the female dancers and asked if she was wearing pasties, she quickly stated no and began to get undressed right in front of P.O. Cabral, P.O. Baas and Sgt. Martin. Her actions were recorded on the officer's department's body worn cameras.
- P.O. Collins stated as he walked through the dance floor, he observed a female dancer performed a lap dance to an unknown male on the dance floor to the left near the DJ booth.
- P.O. Bass, P.O. Cabral, P.O. Collins, P.O. KAZACHENKO, and I all had department issued body worn cameras activated for evidence purposes.

I met the victims outside of the establishment. VIP lounge MKE was just closed at the time of this investigation.

The victims were dressed in security uniforms and stated they were employed with Midwest Intelligence Agency. Victim #1 identified himself as Michael A. FREYTES, W/M, 10/22/1994. Victim #2 identified himself as Wynn C. KITZMAN, (W/M, 01/25/1971)

Regarding the incident, Michael stated he removed an unknown male patron (sus #1) from the establishment. Michael stated sus #1 was causing problems inside of the establishment so he escorted him out. Michael stated sus#1 was reluctant to leave and was being uncooperative. On Monday, December 04, 2017, at approximately 2:04AM, P.O. Taylor BAAS and I (Squad 2472) conducted a tavern check at VIP Lounge located at 828 S. 1st St., which is in the City and County of Milwaukee.

While driving northbound on 900 block S. 1st St. by the VIP Lounge I could hear loud music coming from VIP Lounge. By the time we walked up to the front door the music stopped.

Upon entering the VIP Lounge I observed 40 patrons still on the premises, who were still drinking alcohol beverages.

I spoke with the owner Miguel A. MARTINEZ (W/M, 01/22/79) who was on premises, I asked him if he knew what time the tavern should be close by MARTINEZ answered "2:00AM". I asked MARTINEZ if he knew what time it was now, MARTINEZ answer "2:05AM". MARTINEZ explained that he never get this busy on Sundays and but he had a special party tonight. MARTINEZ said that he called last call at 1:30AM, but he could not explain how all his patrons still were still inside of the VIP Lounge drinking alcohol beverages at 2:05AM.

P.O. BAAS stood by the front door and counted every person that exited VIP Lounge, he counted 40 people. I stood at the south east area of the tavern where I could visibly observe two rear doors, which no one came into or exit.

I advised MARTINEZ of the appropriate hours of his business MARTINEZ.

No other visual violations were observed while we were at the scene.

The Event (Fresh Empire) is held once a month starting in Fall and runs through the school year, and goes from once a month to twice a month, in March, Saturday early evening aprx. 4p and ends between 8p and 9p.

I along with Officer Ciano have worked this event several times over the last year. This is a tobacco-free teen D J event. Ages 13-17 year olds is the group focus. Officers are in Uniform, as Police Presence at the event and for Traffic Control as necessary. MPD is in addition to local Security contractor, Midwest Intelligency Agency, Providing interior and exterior security, as well as searching and wonding all patrons entering the location. Patrons are not allowed to bring in any open containers or back packs. All are lined up outside prior to opening and no exceptions to search.

M I A Security works very well with MPD at this event. They assist with traffic, as well as assist at McDonalds, BP Gas Station, and Mobil Gas Station, at event closing time. As the teens tend to run to those locations and loiter.

To my knowledge I / We have never had issue with teens fighting inside the event.

Starting in Feb. 2018 the Security Contractor will be using metal gates / fencing at the curb line in front of the location to stop the teens from running into the street when exiting the event.

The reason the teens tend to loiter is because several of the parents / guardians to not show up on time to pick their kids up. Along with the event location not letting the teens hang around after the event. The location is closed at 9p sharp, starting there shut down just after 8p.

It should also be noted that the event closes before curfew. The event averages between 250 to 300 in attendance.

We have been able to inform the BP Gas Station and McDonalds when the event is letting out each time. They choose to close their lobby area, which usually last about 30-45 min. The Mobil Gas Station chooses to place someone at the door and monitor 5 in at a time as five depart.

Also MIA Security has purchased Traffic Vest and Guardian Angel Lights to wear when assisting with traffic and loitering issues.

In regards to this past Saturday, 01-20-18. Just after 8p, while location / event was letting out. One of the security guards reported to me that another security guard was missing their back pack. They also stated it may possible have a firearm inside. I immediately called the information out, given the nature of the issue. After a

very quick search of Last Known Area, inside the location. The back Pack was located, with all contents. Note no weapon was located and further investigation revealed that there was never a weapon inside the bag.

Overall I think that an additional few MPD Officers would help with show of presence and help with overall controll of teens until they get picked up. I also think that we need to come up with a drop off and pick up vehicle location, which we will work on at next event, Feb. 2018.

It should also be noted that no alcholo is displyed inside during this event. Soda and water only.

Jacob HOWELL, P.O. Joseph LANZA, Jose RAMIREZ, and I) along with Wisconsin Department of Revenue Special Agents conducted a licensed premises check at VIP Lounge, located at 828 S 1st St.

Officers found the premises to be closed but the licensee, Miguel MARTINEZ, was on-scene, cooperative, and allowed officers into the premises to conduct the investigation.

The investigation revealed thirteen (13) contaminated bottles and twelve (12) bottles with either missing or unreadable/damaged labels, all of which were destroyed by employees.

Dept. of Revenue Special Agents seized eighteen (18) boxes of hookah tobacco from the premises. MARTINEZ stated that he gives the hookah tobacco away with alcohol purchases but does not charge for the tobacco. MARTINEZ does not possess a Cigarette/Tobacco license for the premises and allows the use of hookahs that he furnishes with the complimentary tobacco. The hookahs were left at the premises.

Dept. of Revenue Special Agents also seized one hundred (100) bottles of El Presidente Beer, five (5) open liquor bottles, and fifty-seven (57) sealed liquor bottles that had been purchased from either the previous owner without an invoice or from a source other than a licensed wholesaler.

This report is typed by PO Oscar ESPITIA assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift and tavern squad 2464.

On Saturday March 24th, 2018 at approximately 7:30 PM I responded to 828 S. 1st St. (VIP night club) to assist Officers with a large crowd exiting the club. May it be noted that on the day of the incident, Fresh Empire rented VIP night club for a special event.

Upon arrival I observed several Milwaukee Police Squad vehicles directing traffic eastbound on the 800 block of S. 1st St. In front of the above mentioned address I observed approximately 100 subjects standing in the middle of the street and approximately 200 subjects on the sidewalk. Police officers would asked the subjects to get on the sidewalks, but subjects would ignore officers commands.

The subjects then disbursed walking into several surrounding businesses. When the subjects walked to the surrounding businesses they were walking in the street negatively impacting the flow of traffic in the area.

When I spoke to the Fresh Empire director who identified himself as Travis CHAMBERS. He stated everything was okay until two females inside VIP night club started fighting over a coat. CHAMBERS stated security staff asked all attendees to exit the building. CHAMBERS stated when attendees were outside several more fights broke out. CHAMBERS stated he had approximately 300 teenagers enter the club.

CHAMBERS stated he gives aways 1,500 tickets to Fresh Empire events. Out of that 1,500, approximately 500 children attend the events but he only allows 300 children enter the event.

During this incident we had several calls for police regarding patrons of the Fresh Empire event.

Squad 6021 (PO OTTAWAY) and Squad 6023 (PO EMMONS), arrested the following subjects for Disorderly Conduct Jerald W. HILL (B/M, 05/17/97); Christopher V. DONNELL (B/M, 12/28/01). Jenesha L. BLACK (B/F, 07/10/98) and Shaday E. GOODEN-BROWN (B/F, 01-21-99) were arrested for obstructing.



This report is typed by Police Officer Joseph LANZA, assigned to the District Two Licensed Premise Car, Late Power Shift, Squad 2474, with PO Adam HALASE.

On Thursday, November 23rd, 2017, at approximately 2:20 AM, I was informed by PO Matthew DAVIS that he observed several subjects enter 1619 S. 1st Street., which is the Point's View Boite, after 2:00 AM, which is the established time for bar closing in Milwaukee on Thursdays. PO DAVIS said he also observed a large group of subjects inside the establishment standing at the bar and consuming beverages after 2:00 AM on Thursday, the 23rd.

I arrived at 2:25 AM and attempted to enter the main (east) entrance door and was temporarily blocked by the security at the door. The security told me no one else was allowed to enter. I informed him I was a Police Officer and he apologized, saying he didn't immediately recognize me.

I observed a large group of subjects inside the establishment and would later count them and discover approximately forty patrons were inside the establishment. I did not do an exact count; I counted those seated at the bar and those consuming alcoholic beverages. I observed one bartender behind the bar moving quickly from patron to patron as he accepted currency and served each one. I stopped my count at forty as I began to speak with the owner and licensee, identified as Marcos RAMOS-GARCIA.

RAMOS-GARCIA said he believed bar close was at 2:30 AM on Holidays, to include Thanksgiving, New Years, and Christmas. RAMOS-GARCIA explained he is a new business owner, and is not familiar with all the rules. I informed him I know bar close to be 2:00 AM on Thanksgiving.

RAMOS-GARCIA was cooperative and apologetic. RAMOS-GARCIA said if he was incorrect about closing on Thanksgiving it would not happen again. RAMOS-GARCIA expressed his interest in maintaining his establishment as a safe business in compliance with tavern regulations.

This concludes my report.

This report is written by PO Benjamin SPITZER, District Two, Late Power.

On Saturday, March 31st, 2018 at approximately 2:41AM while assigned to SQ 2464 (PO Matthew SCOTT and I) conducted a tavern check at 1619 S. 1st St, Points View Boite.

While monitoring bar close in the Walker's Point area I observed a large amount of patrons within the Points View Boite. We then conducted a tavern check at the listed tavern regarding the observed violation. Upon making entry to the business the security had the door locked. Security opened the door, and upon entering the location the bartenders immediately began to yell it's time to go, and everyone has to go. I observed a large quantity of patrons at the bar still consuming beverages, and several bartenders behind the counter.

All patrons exited the business through the front door. PO Gregory KNOX (SQ 2490) was at the rear exit to the business, and did not observe any patrons leave through the rear exit. PO SCOTT and I each counted the number of patrons who exited the tavern. We both counted sixteen (16) patrons who exited the tavern approximately fifteen minutes past bar close. It should be noted that it only took approximately two to three minutes for the patrons to clear out.

I spoke with the owner, identified as Marcos A. RAMOS-GARCIA (W/M, 03-01-85), who stated that they had a very busy night. RAMOS-GARCIA stated that they were having a difficult time closing patron's bar tabs and getting people out of the business. I advised RAMOS-GARCIA that he should have done last call at a sooner time to ensure all patrons were out past bar close. I also advised RAMOS-GARCIA that his excuse was unsatisfactory due to the fact it only took a few minutes to get the remaining patrons out of the tavern once we entered the business. I advised RAMOS-GARCIA he could receive a citation for this incident, and that District Two would be in contact with him to set up a meeting regarding this matter.

On Friday, April 6, 2018, at 11:00 AM, Captain Alexander RAMIREZ, Sergeant Chad RADEN, P.O. Oscar PICENO, A.C.A. Heather HOUGH, and I met with the licensee of Point's View Boite, Marcos A RAMOS-GARCIA, which is located at 1619 S 1st St regarding an after-hours incident that had occurred on March 3, 2018.

The meeting began with a summary of the two licensed premises checks that occurred at the location on the above date. Captain RAMIREZ explained that the police department is obligated to respond to complaints made by citizens, that he (Captain RAMIREZ) wants to see businesses succeed in the district but that they must be run in a responsible manner, and he (Captain RAMIREZ) voiced his concern that his was the second after-hours violation occurring at the premises under new ownership.

SGT. RADEN addressed the following points:

Facebook posts for the premises that include events that the premises is not licensed for (dancing by performers).

Lingerie shows should be listed on the license even if they are not exotic dancing.

A.C.A. HOUGH mentioned the PIVOT program and meeting with Alderman PEREZ and/or D2 CPU to go over a business plan to ensure that the proper licenses have been obtained. A.C.A. HOUGH and I both mentioned that the first after-hours incident that had occurred in November should have been an adequate warning that the premises cannot deviate from hours on the license and/or stay open past bar close.

RAMOS-GARCIA felt that he was treated unfairly because numerous officers entered the premises to conduct the investigation. RAMOS-GARCIA stated that he would begin the closing process earlier (2:00AM) in order to ensure that patrons are out of the premises before 2:30 AM. RAMOS-GARCIA stated that he would obtain the necessary licenses to have employees dance and in order to conduct dancing lessons inside of the premises.







Hello, Milwaukee Licenses Committee.

My name is I'm the actually attended a few license hearings in the past to express concern with the track record and conflict of hours of a neighborhood bar that is located right across the street from our all girls middle school campus.

Notre Dame School of Milwaukee is located at 1420 W. Scott St. I'm writing in regards to the bar established by David Torres and his wife located at 1500 W Scott St, Milwaukee, WI 53204. The bar currently has hours that commence after our school day has ended. This way, we are guaranteed that our students will not possibly be subject to any precarious situations or onlookers stumbling out of the bar. We at NDSM are deeply committed to the growth of this community and fully believe that we the bar opening at 3 pm instead of 6 pm will not be a positive influence to the community let alone our school. Our school day ends each day between 5 and 6 pm depending on students' mandatory after school program schedule.

The bar is directly across the street from our parking lot beside our school where ours students go outside to decompress during recess, to observe shadows for science projects, and to do other academic performances all the way through dismissal.

In the past, the problems that have emanated from Mr. Torres' bar appear to have resulted from circumstances beyond his control. For example, at one point there were reports of a patron of the bar outside of the bar smoking and looking into the parking lot where our young women students were engaged in a learning activity. Reports came across my desk that the individual was gauking at the students. The students reported feeling "uncomfortable" and felt as if they were being "checked out." There have been a few experiences in the past like this that directly affected our students. These incidents do not include other forms of illegal activity such as a shooting in 2015.

Recently, I received a voicemail from Mr. Torres indicating that he wanted to expand the hours of the bar. Opening at 3pm instead of 6pm. I expressed to him via text message that the school agreed to co-exist with the bar if the hours did not conflict back in 2016. I explained that we could not support his appeal to expand the bar's hours out of the interest and security of our students and faculty.

We have more than enough reason to believe that the bar's presence isn't making a positive contribution to the neighborhood. Parents, students, and faculty of Notre Dame School of Milwaukee unanimously feel the same. I ask that you consider our case in determining that the bar's start time shouldn't change.


