



- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



On Wednesday, November 15th, 2017 at 7:53 PM, Squad 5222 (P.O. Tyler SEELOW and myself) was dispatched to an Armed Robbery complaint at 3876 N Port Washington Rd, North Port Food &Liquor.

We arrived at 7:56 PM and found the business occupied by 2 employees, Sukhdev SINGH (w/m 03-23-94) and Maurice HARROLD (b/m 11-20-60). SINGH had been working behind the register as a cashier and HARROLD was working as security/greeter.

During the course of the armed robbery, approximately \$500-\$600 dollars was taken from the register along with approximately 25 bottles of liquor from behind the cashier's counter. I observed that the store seemed to be only half way stocked with large open spaces including the entire south wall. Approximately half of the ceiling tiles had yet to be installed. No security cameras were installed at the location. SINGH was unable to provide me with any license information at the time. The store licenses was not on his person nor was it displayed anywhere in the store.
