Subject: 2009 Highway Safety Improvement Program
West Oklahoma Avenue and South 35th Street

Dear Council Members:

The 2009 Capitol Improvement Program includes the installation of traffic signal improvements at the subject intersection under the 2009 Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). Traffic signal improvements at this location include the installation of left turn arrows for southbound traffic on South 35th Street.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$4,126.08. Ninety percent of the total cost, or \$3,713.47, will be funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT). The local share, or \$412.61, will be provided through the Division's existing Capital Improvement Program.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works and Comptroller to execute a Local Force Account (LFA) – Local contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install traffic signal improvements under the 2009 HSIP at the intersection of West Oklahoma Avenue and South 35th Street in the 8th and 11th Aldermanic Districts.
