Due to concerns from residents and concerned citizens, and at your request, we recommend the following changes:

The Removal of:

“Two-Hour Meter Parking, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday-Friday, Two-Hour Parking 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Saturday, One dollar and fifty cents per hour.”

The Installation of:

“Ten-Hour Meter Parking, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday-Friday, Ten-Hour Parking 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Saturday, One quarter per hour.”

If you have no objection to the above, we will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee so that you may support it to final passage.

We previously covered the No Parking restriction on North Oakland Avenue, from East Hartford Avenue to a point 60 feet south on a trial basis and found that additional parking could be restored in this area and still allow traffic flow by repealing the above-captioned parking restriction. Since this trail has been in effect for a substantial time period and we have not received any complaints, we recommend a permanent removal.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
