This is in response to a request we received from Mr. Dale Radke to install the above-captioned traffic control restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that since the intersection of West Melvina Street and North 66th Street is currently operating as a marked school crossing and is a pedestrian entrance to Dineen Park, we are recommending the installation of an all-way stop in an effort to increase pedestrian safety at the intersection.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
