In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Sign shall be installed into mortar joints. No bricks may be penetrated to install the sign.
Sign is for temporary use only and is not up to the standard required for permanent signs. *This sign is allowed for a maximum of 120 days, or fewer as required by the zoning code.*

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within 180 days of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
