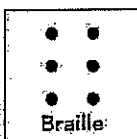


Let this letter serve as notice that we are filing an appeal regarding our dog, Gidget, being classified as a dangerous animal. We feel this decision was made based solely on the injuries sustained by the child on 06/20/2018 and the account of the family. Yes, the extent of the child's injuries was terrible, but more than once her father said to people that his daughter was "attacked" by a dog. This is a lie. Gidget did not attack the child. The parents were fully aware that abuse trauma and a head injury led Gidget to sometimes be unpredictable if she was startled or frightened. Several attempts were made to put Gidget somewhere away from everyone but the child's mother insisted that we allow her to stay out because her daughter loves dogs and had been around Gidget before. While we were outside, the child asked her parents if she could pet Gidget and they gave their permission. Gidget was playing happily and came over to greet her and she pet her on the back. There was absolutely no problem at this time. However, a little while later, Gidget had taken one of her toys and was lying down with it when the child came up beside her and tried to touch her head. It was at this time that Gidget was startled and she turned and bit the child. Again, she did not attack the child. It was one bite and she immediately let go. Had it been an adult who had startled her and been bit, it would have been an injury to the hand. However, given the height of the child, the bite was, unfortunately, to her face. It was a terrible accident, and I deeply regret that I did not follow my own instincts to put Gidget somewhere else while we had friends over.

That being said, in the almost eight years since we rescued Gidget, she has never once displayed aggression or malice to any person or dog. As I said, she has, on occasion, snapped at us if we startle her, but she has never just snapped at us or tried to harm us – or any other guest we have ever had – in any way. When we go out for walks, she is excited and happy when she sees people and loves when they stop to pet her. On these walks, there are also several neighborhood dogs whom she will greet excitedly. She has never once tried to go after another animal or even barked at people or animals as they pass. Nor has she ever been aggressive towards strangers who may walk by our house when she is in the yard. We have several neighbors and other people who have spent time with Gidget who are willing to write letters attesting to the fact that she is not a mean or aggressive dog. She is a dog who was startled and who thought she needed to protect herself. While the child did not purposely antagonize or provoke Gidget, the lawyer we spoke with informed us that provocation of a dog

does not have to be intentional. Something as simple as a child trying to give a dog a hug could startle it and it may feel threatened and that, according to the lawyer, constitutes a form of provocation. I am in no way saying that the child or anyone else is to blame in this situation, but it needs to be clear that this was not a case of a dog just lunging at or maliciously attacking a child. We have every intention of ensuring that something like this does not happen again by making sure that Gidget is put in a separated area when we have people over. However, we feel that there needs to be more of an actual "investigation" into the situation before our dog is classified as dangerous or vicious.

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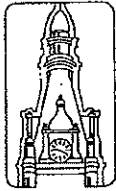



Violations of Chapter 78-23 and 78-25 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances must be appealed in writing to Attn: DNS Residential Division Manager, 4001 S 6th St, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Milwaukee WI 53221. Phone 414-286-5771.

If an appeal is pursued, it is your responsibility, as the appellant, to file with the appropriate department. Please contact the inspector that issued this order if you are unclear on this issue. Filing an appeal with the incorrect department may render your appeal null and void.

#### REINSPECTION FEES

In accordance with Section 200-33-48, a fee may be charged for any reinspection, except no fee shall be charged for the final reinspection when compliance is recorded. The fee is \$101.60 for the first reinspection, \$203.20 for the second and all subsequent reinspections. These fees include a 1.6% training and technology surcharge. Reinspection fees shall be a lien upon the real estate where the reinspections were made and shall be assessed and collected as a special tax. If you wish to contest the assessment of a reinspection fee, contact the inspector, and, if necessary, the inspector's supervisor. If no agreement is reached, an appeal form will be mailed to you, which you can complete and send to the City's Administrative Review Appeals Board. 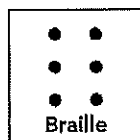

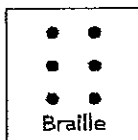
