5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

We plan to build a 4 car garage on the back of our property, directly behind the existing house on the lot of 2018 N 1st Street. Currently there is no garage, but a gravel driveway.

The garage will be built in the historic Victorian style of the homes in the neighborhood. Dimensions of the garage are 22' x 40' and the pitch of the roof matches the house. The garage begins The following will be done:

- * excavate ground for new frost wall garage foundation
- * Strip topsoil inside garage location, removal of existing gravel/concrete
- * Excavate and place gravel/stone based down around perimeter of garage, 20'x40' area
- * Excavate for 124 feet of footings, 4' deep trench walls
- * Add concrete curb on perimeter of foundation walls
- * Pour 124 feet of 8"x20" footings, to be installed under new concrete wall
- * Install #1 stone around inside of foundation walls, 30 yards of stone figured.
- * Pour 4" thick garage floor and pour along the new foundation walls
- * Install 1/2" anchor bolts to code
- * Install 2"x6" x 9' 8" exterior garage walls at 16" OC
- * Install 7/16" OSB sheathing on exterior of walls
- * Install 2"x6" rafters at 16" OC
- * Install a pre-engineered roof truss system
- * Install 1/2" OSB sheathing on top of the room rafters/trusses with H clips
- * Install open overhangs on outer edge of structure rakes and 12" open eaves to match existing
- * Install Tyvek house wrap on exterior
- * Install a pine wood set of stairs to the second floor
- * Install pine 2x10's for the treads and install pine 1x8 for the risers.
- * Install 3/4" OSB flooring in the area above the garage.
- * Install engineered wood siding LP SmartSide siding on the sides of the new garage.
- * Install LP Smart Side cedar shake materials for the upper gables.
- * Install LP products for the soffit and 4/4" x 8" fascia material.
- * Install 5/4" trim boards at all corner details.
- * Bend 4" x 4" gutter apron to match the color of the new gutters. (Color: _WHITE__
- * Install 5" seamless aluminum gutters and 4" down spouts on the garage. (Color: WHITE_)
- * Install two rows of CertainTeed Winterguard Ice & Water shield at gutter line and continue with synthetic underlayment paper to the ridge on new addition.
- * Install windows with vinyl casement
