Substitute resolution granting permanent historic designation of the property at 216-222 East Mason Street, the Milwaukee News Building and Milwaukee Abstract Association Building, in the 4th Aldermanic District.

Body:

Whereas, The Milwaukee Historic Preservation Ordinance, s. 320-21 of the Code of Ordinances, provides that historic sites, structures and districts may be designated by the Common Council upon the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Commission; and

Whereas, The Historic Preservation Commission, at its July 2, 2018 meeting, by a vote of four (4) ayes and two (2) excused, recommended historic designation of the property at 216-222 East Mason Street, the Milwaukee News Building and Milwaukee Abstract Association Building, and

Whereas, This building fulfills the following criterion set forth in s. 320-21-3:

- e-1. Its exemplification and development of the cultural, economic, social or historic heritage of the city, state of Wisconsin or the United States
- e-5. Its embodiment of distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type or specimen
- e-6. Its identification as the work of an architect, craftsman or master builder whose individual works have influenced the development of the city

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the property at 216-222 East Mason Street, the Milwaukee News Building and Milwaukee Abstract Association Building, further described as:

PLAT OF MILWAUKEE IN SECS (28-29-33)-7-22 BLOCK 10 W 40' LOT 6 BID #21 be designated as a Milwaukee historic site. The Preservation Guidelines pursuant to the Historic Designation Study Report, a copy of which is attached to this file, shall apply to this site and is adopted by the Common Council as part of this file.
