## WHAT'S NEXT

A nationwide **search for a new Executive Director** is underway, led by a committee of the PAVE + STCM Board of Directors.

Once hired, the new Executive Director individual will lead the formal launch of the new combined organization under a **new name**, following **brief strategic planning**.

**Until then**, all programming will continue as planned under Interim Executive Director Rashida Evans. Rashida is also the organization's Chief Program Officer.

**Already**, our combined team is providing an **integrated continuum of programs** to empower school leaders and school governance boards at the city's district, charter, and private schools.



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# **OUR RESULTS**

## BY INVESTING IN SCHOOL LEADERS, WE IMPROVE STUDENT OUTCOMES AT SCHOOLS ACROSS THE CITY.

We monitor five key indicators to measure success:

#### WE ARE CLOSING THE ACHIEVEMENT GAP.

Wisconsin's school report card shows students at PAVE + STCM-supported schools experience **more and faster academic growth** than the average school anywhere in the state.

### **2.** WE ARE DEVELOPING GREAT SCHOOL LEADERS.

114 Our Emerging Leaders Program has developed 114 leaders.

**32** Our **Burke Fellowship** has graduated 32 leaders with principal licenses.

100+ Our Board Corps program has developed more than 100 leaders.

96% of school leaders receiving Ongoing Coaching said it enhanced their effectiveness and capacity.

#### **3.** WE ARE RETAINING GREAT SCHOOL LEADERS.

>84% More than 84% of PAVE + STCMsupported school leaders returned to their position in fall 2018, exceeding the 73% national average for high-poverty schools.

# **4**. LEADERS ARE COLLABORATING ACROSS ALL SCHOOL SECTORS.

**150** leaders from **MPS, charter, and private schools** participate in our monthly professional development Collaboratives.

96% of leaders say cross-sector networking and collaborating with other leaders has been valuable.

# 5. HIGH-QUALITY SCHOOLS ARE SERVING MORE STUDENTS.

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Since 2010, PAVE + STCM has committed **over \$3M** to add seats in existing high-quality schools and highpotential new school starts.
