Preferred Route Selection

- 3 routes were evaluated
- Preferred route is Alternative 1, which travels along Oklahoma Ave within City of Milwaukee limits.
- Upcoming transmission main construction will be confined to Oklahoma Ave between 74th St on the east and city limits on the west.
- Selection of this route shortens the total distance of water main construction.
- At a later date, the main in Oklahoma Ave from 60th St to 74th St will be upgraded.





Pumping Station Site Selection

- 7 sites were evaluated
- Preferred site is near the intersection of 76th St and Oklahoma Ave.
- Selection of this site allows MWW to decommission a nonconforming underground pumping station nearby.
- Acquisition of the parcel will occur over the next few months.
- The pump station is contract package #1 anticipated construction is March 2020 through April 2021


Ensuring Water Quality

- Installation of "Pipe Loop" at Grange Pumping Station
- Will monitor the interaction of our water with pipes harvested from Waukesha
- Analyzes how different water (groundwater versus lake water) reacts with pipe materials based on the different characteristics of the water.
- Avoids water quality problems when switching sources.

Schedule Moving Forward


- Permitting Completed by September 2019
