Your Extended Hours Establishments, Class B Tavern, Public Enterprises, and Food Dealer License Renewal Applications as agent for "JALISCO RESTAURANT, LLC" for "JALISCO RESTAURANT" at 1035 S CESAR E CHAVEZ DR.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquirles regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



Up until recently we have enjoyed coming Jalisco Restaurant over the years for the food and the great service. Unfortunately, after our visit this past Sunday morning this view has changed dramatically for us.

This past Sunday one of our friend was celebrating his birthday, my wife and I brought him and other friends to the Restaurant. Instead of the usual delightful service and fare we encountered an extremely long waiting time for more than what I estimated "one hour". Usually the waitress stop by withing 5- to 10 minutes from the time that we seat on the table and ask for the order of drinks (but not at this time).

The issue started when I ask the female waitress,

Me..." my friend can you tell me when you going to take are order at lease of drink because we ben waiting about an hour and no one have stop by here to take are order"

Waitress..."It's a problem with the security guard we don't serve"

Me..."my friend and what that have to be with me or my food and repeat no no that have nothing to do with me. Waitress walk a way during my conversation with her.

I notice the male gentleman that all way is there and wish we have previously thanks him for the the great service of the Restaurant. I ask him if he was the owner of the Restaurant and he replay to me No Im the manager wish I tell him I really dislike there I was talking with the waitress and she keep walking away from me (wish I field very disrespected at that time). I try it to start to explained my experience with the waitress to the manager but the waitress come back in the mittle of my oficial comlaint and she lie about there I want her to serve us.(like "I was forcing her") at this time the Manager don't let me talk because he want to talk and I said ok, ok tell me and he continue said "If we have problem here we don't serve" and I replay to him before the problem I was waiting and that problem have nothing to do with me or my food. Meanwhile the security officer (the owner of the security company Jose Carrasquillo) was standing "stand by" next to the manager as the manager said that he "tell me before" that the food would be delayed for 5 to 10 minutes (wish he never tell me that nor have a talk to us that morning about anything) therefore security guard introduce him self to the conversation without invitation between an Official complaint about the unsatisfactory customer service and a manager of the Restaurant. The Officer Jose Carrasquillo after ben unprofessional and respectful adding the we haven't be there for that amount of time in a confrontational manner, we tell the manager that we not longer want the service and I excuse my self and as we was leaving I repeat in multiple occasions to the manager "Thank you my friend" expecting from him an apology but never happens. Its very disappointed and unfortunately not receive the same level of professionalism and a great service as Jalisco Restaurant have provide us in a multiples occasions before.

As we was leaving the security officer (Jose Carrasquillo) following us to out side of the Restaurant and continuously reclaiming us that we haven't ben there that long that we should not complaint about it and I replay him "are you crazy? If Im not satisfied with the service I can complain brother" and he repeat you have to listen to me..you're wrong. I tell him no, noo, nooo you have to listen because Im the client and he holt his gun and tell me when ever you want today Im who have the belt on not you I told him you're right because I don't have my (thinking that he was referring about the authority of the uniform because he know there

till he mention...when ever you want we can go for it and at that time he appear to grab his gun and bring it half away of his holster and put it back down on the holster and repeatly screaming at me when ever you want and how you wan it feest or we can shoot each other what ever you want any where PAPA I felt threat and my wife and I go to my car and as we was pulling out the parking I scream at him...I lost your respect, lisen I lost your respect aloding of the level of professionalim and he scream back at me I pass your respect between my legs, "mother fucker."

I have to mention there I haven't ben the 1st one there this security Officer have problem in are community and have ben occasions there this Officer have follow with his guards and intimidating members of are community he even have slash tires after following peoples.

My wife and I went to the Police station to report my experience there with the security officer around 4am, I was received by a male Police Office wish I ask if was possible for me to talk wth the Supervisor on shift and I try it to explain my experience and the Police Office tell me the Supervisor would not come in unless I complain about an Police Officer only, So I tell my experience and he tell us the we have to wait because was some Officers responding to the same address there I was coming from so we wait. I fall of sleep few minutes because I was tire and field sick with nasal congestion. After few minutes Officer come back and tell us that security Officer from where I was coming from make a complaint against us and taking 22yrs of experience If I make a complaint against the security Officer I would loose in court because as he can see I have glosses eyes and he can see there I was intoxicated and they are about 10 Officer again 2 people there I would never win a case like that and If I pursuit the complaint he would testify there I was intoxicated. By the Police Officer recommendations I should think about it and call him later during the day or the day after if I want to pursuit a complain against any one. One more time my wife and I left with unsatisfactory customer service that we have received from the most highest educated and professinals of the Police Deparment, District 2.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- On 03/01/2015 Milwaukee police were flagged down at South Cesar E Chavez Drive and West Mineral Street regarding a shots fired complaint. The victim told officers that while she was eating inside Jalisco Restaurant (1035 South Cesar E Chavez Drive), her vehicle was struck multiple times by gun fire. Milwaukee police incident report #150600016 filed.
- 2. On 03/13/2015 Milwaukee police, while on patrol, observed two subjects arguing while outside Jalisco's Restaurant. These subjects told officers they had been at local taverns and planned on going into Jalisco's to get food. These subjects left the area without incident.

3. On 11/04/15, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1035 S Cesar Chavez, Jalisco's Restaurant, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. Police spoke with the manager Fidel Morales-Maccdo who stated he has a verbal argument with a patron over her take out order and that the patron was asked to leave. The patron pulled out a hand gun from her waist band and climbed through the take out window into the restaurant area and threatened him. The suspect took a food order that was not hers and that she did not pay for it and then exited the business. Security on scene then detained her until police arrived. A black BB gun was recovered from the area where the suspect was detained.

- 4. On 05/15/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a trouble with the subject complaint at 1035 South Cesar E. Chavez Drive. Investigation revealed an employee of the security company used by Jaliscos, pepper sprayed a group of patrons that had become offensive and disorderly.
- 5. On 09/22/2018 officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint that took place outside of Jalisco's Restaurant at 1035 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. Upon arrival the officers found a subject lying on the ground in front of a wheel chair. The subject was conveyed to Froedtert Hospital where he was placed on a ventilator to help him breath. The investigation revealed that J.C. Security was employed by Jalisco's restaurant and video was obtained that showed two of their security guards kicking and punching the victim. The owner of J.C. Security stated the outside cameras did not work but the manager of Jalisco's stated they did work but he could not access them. The manager was very cooperative with the officers and advised them the person that could access the cameras would be in at 11:00am.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Nicholas WILCKENS assigned to District 2 late power shift, squad 2420.

On Saturday September 22nd at 3:33 AM my partner P.O. KNAPINSKI and I were dispatched to the location of 1035 S Cesar E. Chavaz Dr. for the report of a battery that had taken place outside of the Jalisco's restaurant. Upon arrival to the scene I observed a man lying in front of a wheelchair unresponsive. The man was taken to Froedtert Hospital, when we heard the man was put on a ventilator to assist him breathing. During my investigation video of part of the altercation was found by another officer on scene, showing at least two J.C. Public Safety officers punching and kicking the victim who was in the wheelchair outside the front of the restaurant. When I asked the owner of J.C. Security if the cameras worked outside of the store he replied that they did not. I then went to talk to the manager who was working at the time who identified himself as Julio B. CACERES w/m (1/6/1955) who told me that the cameras did indeed work but that he was just the night shift manager and that the person who had access to the cameras would be into work at 11:00 AM. CACERES brought me to where he kept all of the restaurant license's and let me verify that they were all up to date. CACERES was very cooperative with my investigation of the stores video surveillance as well as the investigation of the J.C. security officers that were employed by Jalisco's.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- , a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.





- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.


