There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

## Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Regarding the upcoming license renewal at Genes Unicorn 3412 W National Ave, I have many concerns.

First and foremrrost, it is the level of late night noise as it has been a persistent problem over the past few months.

As we have had a warm start to fall, I would love to sit in my backyard to enjoy the cool, mosquito free evenings. On several evenings, as I was trying to do this, I was forced inside because of the loud, drunken conversations going on at my neighbors property. Who can relax to that? My understanding is that the dance studio at 3417 complained about people smoking on the front street. Certainly they were aware of the environment when they leased the property. Now that windows are closed, noise is still a problem when I am in the back of my house. As people get drunker, the volume gets louder. When I move to the front of my house to sleep on my couch to avoid the noise, I am awoken by more loud voices at 1:30am and then again at 2:00 am. Then the horn beeping and screeching tires begins.

Second, litter including broken half-pint and beer bottles along the area closest to National Ave is pretty pervasive. I've swept up broken bottles from the street 2 times in the last few months.

Third, as my evening outdoor enjoyment has been moved to the front of my house, I notice the level of intoxication that some people have. I've seen several people pin-balling their way down 34th St. I know that people have fallen in my garden, wiping out an entire summers worth of asiatic lilies. I once witnessed someone stagger out of the bar and collapse near their car. A few minutes later, 2 friends rushed out, got the person in the car, then sped away. Opioid overdose? Alcohol over-intoxication? Fourth, 2 years ago, my house caught a bullet, as did the two houses north of me. Another neighbor caught a bullet in the grill of her car. We have no way of knowing the origination of the bullets, but I do know it happened after midnight. Neighbors felt it likely originated from patrons From Genes.

Fifth, safety. Although I generally feel safe in my neighborhood, over the past few months I've been restricting my dog's bedtime walks to closer to home. Whereas I used to walk to the corner of 34th an National to see what was happening, I now only go halfway as I am often met with boisterous people leaving the bar, which of course, my dog has an adverse reaction to. Shane approached me on Saturday about his upcoming license renewal. I told him I would be writing a letter regarding my concerns. Through the course of the conversation, I did not feel that Shane feels entirely safe when in our neighborhood....oh the irony of that!

I am sure the licensing committee can make recommendations to assist with improvements Shane can make to once again make Genes a respected neighborhood recreational facility. On many levels, I feel Shane is operating as an absentee landlord, collecting the profits without putting a lot of effort into it. He is lucky to have a few dedicated daytime employees who put a lot of effort into running the establishment. I think further improvements could be made by Shane picking up a few weekend night time shifts to see what happens when he's not around. I think we also need a better solution to the backyard use by a patrons as well.

My apologies for not being able to appear in person, but this is what happens when you use all your vacation time trying to make a beautiful backyard, that in the end you can't enjoy anyway.

Officers spoke with the victim who stated he was sitting at the bar when a known actor came in stating the victim owed him some money. The actor pushed the victim and a fight started. The victim was convey to a near by hospital where he was treated for a fractured ankle. A report was filed.

8. On 06/22/09 at 5:27 pm, Milwaukee police were working the Wisconsin Wins Tobacco Initiative and had an underage female enter 3412 W National in attempts to purchase cigarettes. The underage was able to receive dollar coins from the bartender who then purchased a pack of cigarettes from the vending machine. The bartender never asked for any identification. The licensee, Shane Parker was cited for Sale of Cigarettes to Minor/Underage at 3412 W National Avenue.

9. On 04/10/10 at 8:40 pm, applicant was arrested by Greendale Police Department for OWI.

10. On 03/01/11 at 11:23 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3412 W National Avenue for a Trouble With Subject complaint. Officers spoke with the bartender Delora Woods who stated that a customer inside the bar kept making unwanted passes at her and she asked the patron to leave, but he refused and started to disturb other customers. The subject was still on scene at police arrival and he was advised that he was no longer welcomed in the bar.

- 11.On 07/05/11 at 11:30 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3412 W National for a Battery complaint. Investigation revealed a patron who had left the tavern was beaten by four unknown males and needed stitches to close his wounds. While officers were conducting follow up regarding the battery, they observed 3 patrons leave the bar who began fighting fight one another outside the bar causing a disturbance and crowd to gather. These three patrons were highly intoxicated and refusing to listen to police commands. Additional police squads were called and the subjects were citing for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing an Officer.
- 12. On 08/04/10, applicant was convicted of OWI in Milwaukee County. His license was revoked for 30 months.
- 13. On 01/11/13 at 5:57 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3412 W National Avenue to check for a crime scene regarding a Battery/Cutting complaint. Police spoke to Terri Rainbird who was bartending. Rainbird stated that two males were verbally arguing inside the bar when they both exited and started to physically fight with their fists. Investigation found that one of the subjects fighting stabbed the other outside of the Unicorn tavern.

- 14. On 10/05/13 at 10:48 pm, Milwaukee police observed a fight outside of Gene's Unicorm Pub at 3412 W National Avenue. Investigation found two patrons started to verbally argue inside the bar when they were ordered to leave by the bartender Juana Williams. Both subjects left, but continued to physically fight outside until police arrived. A third subject approached police during the investigation and told police that he was armed with a gun and had a valid CCW permit. He also admitted to consuming alcohol while inside the bar. This subject was arrested and a charge of ESBUODW is pending against him. Williams told police that she was unaware that anyone was armed while inside the bar.
- 15. On 02/16/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 3412 West National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn). No violations were observed.
- 16. On 10/05/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a loud music complaint at 3412 West National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn Pub II). Officers could hear music from outside of the business and noticed that the front door of the tavern was propped open. The bartender, Juana Williams, stated the business was very crowed and he did not notice that the front door was open. He closed the door, had the music turned down and told officers the business was about to close for the night anyway. The person who reported the problem did not wish to be a complainant for a citation.
- 17. On 10/23/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 3412 West National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn Pub II). The victim told officers he had been involved in a verbal confrontation with two other patrons while inside the bar. This later escalated into a physical confrontation outside of the business. The victim told officers that the other parties involved left prior to police arrival and he did not want police services. The bartender, Juana Williams, was cooperative and no violations were observed.

- 18. On 12/05/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 3412 West National Avenue (Unicorn Pub II). No violations were observed.
- 19. On 01/17/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a trouble with a subject complaint at 3412 West National Avenue. The bartender, Annette Wilber, told officers there had been an argument inside the bar between three subjects, but they all left prior to officer's arrival.
- 20. On 01/31/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 3412 West National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn Pub 2). No violations were observed.
- 21.On 04/16/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 3412 West National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn Pub). Investigation revealed a patron of the business attempted to leave the business with a drink. The bartender informed the patron that she couldn't leave with the drink. The husband of the bartender attempted to stop the patron at the door from leaving with the drink. The patron produced a handgun and fired two shots while inside the business, striking the bartenders husband in the arm. Milwaukee police incident report #151060009 filed.

22. On 05/25/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight at 3412 West National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn II). Investigation revealed the victim was punched multiple times while inside the business, causing a broken nose and bruised eye. During this investigation, officers conducted a licensed premise check which revealed no violations. Milwaukee police incident report #161470118 filed.

- 23. On 09/05/2017 at 9:27pm officers went to The Green Unicorn Pub, 3412 W. National Av, to conduct follow up regarding a shooting. The officers watched surveillance video from 09/05/2017 at 1:27am. The video depicted a fight inside between a male and female patron. The bartender, Kristine WILMER, and another male subject attempted to stop the fight. While attempting the stop the fight, the male subject helping the bartender pulled out a gun from his waist band. The male suspect charged toward the subject with the gun and the subject fired one time at the suspect. Both subjects then left the bar. WILMER is observed later in the video picking something, possibly the casing from the bullet, off the floor and taking it outside. WILMER denies picking up a casing and told the officers she did not think the shooting happened inside the bar. The applicant was contacted by phone and stated he believed the shooting occurred outside his establishment. The tavern made no calls to the police regarding this incident.
- 24. On 09/20/2017 a meeting was held regarding the shooting on 09/05/2017 at Gene's Unicorn, 3412 W. National Ave. At the meeting was the applicant, Alderman DONOVAN, and Captain RAMIREZ. The applicant stated he trains his employees to call the Police if there is an incident at the tavern. He stated he has fired the employee involved and is attempting to identify the patrons involved so he can ban them from the tavern. He is considering better lighting in the rear of the tavern and increase security during busy hours. He will be posting a sign to prohibit firearms. Alderman DONOVAN recommended the applicant close at 12:00am on weekdays and 1:00am on weekends and place a camera and lighting at the rear of the business.

25. On 03/26/18 at 12:29am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3412 W. National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn Pub) for a subject with gun complaint. The caller/employee called police and stated a patron pointed a firearm at her. The patron was located and arrested. An Incident report was filed (180850002)

26. On 08/01/18 an email was sent to the Second District from an alderman wanting an investigation into a fight which happened on 07/28/18 in front of 3412 W. National Avenue (Gene's Unicorn tavern). In the email, there was a link which captured a fight in front of the location and mentioned employees of the tavern. Investigation revealed that there were no calls for service at the establishment on 07/28/18 and there was no victim, who filed a police report. An employee and security were interviewed but neither one stated they saw a fight.

#### PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Benjamin SPITZER, District Two, Late Power.

On Monday, March 26th, 2018 at 12:29AM while assigned to SQ 2464 (PO ESPITIA and I) were dispatched to 3412 W. National Av, Gene's Unicom Pub, to assist SQ 2420 (GOLLUP/KNOX) for a subject with a gun complaint.

The bartender and caller, identified as Loretta M. TURNER (B/F, 12-18-76), called stating there was a patron inside of the tavern armed with a revolver. On arrival PO KNOX and PO GOLLUP observed the subject, matching the description given, outside of the tavern on the sidewalk. PO GOLLUP took the subject into custody, identified as Dawuan R. ROBINSON (B/M, 01-09-90), but the firearm was not located.

I spoke with TURNER who stated the subject identified as ROBINSON was in the tavern arguing with another patron. TURNER stated as she was walking behind the counter when she observed ROBINSON brandished what she describe as a black revolver, and point it directly towards her. TURNER stated that she was able to get all of the patrons including ROBINSON outside, and lock up the tavern. TURNER stated that she then immediately called the Police. PO GOLLUP and I viewed the video which shows ROBINSON brandish the firearm and point it at TURNER. While ROBINSON is outside he drops the firearm on the ground several times. ROBINSON then enters an unknown make, or model, vehicle for a brief period of time. Approximately thirty seconds after exiting the vehicle, PO GOLLUP and PO KNOX, arrived on scene and made contact with ROBINSON. As they are dealing with ROBINSON the same vehicle drives away westbound on W. National Ave. ROBINSON most likely dumped the observed firearm in this vehicle prior to the Officers arrival.

TURNER was very cooperative with our investigation, and no tavern violations were observed. On 3-26-18 PO GOLLUP presented this case to ADA Lucy KRONFROST who issued charges of ESBUDW and DC while armed.

On Wednesday, August 1, 2018, the office Alderman Robert Donovan sent an email to MPD2@milwaukee.gov that read as follows:

"Hi Sgt. Kaltenbrun",

The video below was posted this past Saturday, and it appears to be of a fight out in front of Gene's Unicorn at 3412 W. National Ave. Later in the video, the bartender and security are mentioned, so we are assuming these people had just left the bar. Do you have any calls for service to this bar this past weekend?

The email contained the above link to a video posted by a "Dominique Nolan" which depicted a fight that occurred outside of Gene's Unicorn. Posting has a date/time stamp of "July 28, 2018 12:31AM". P.O. Christopher AGNEW captured the video from FACEBOOK and copied it to a CD-R, P.O. VODICKA placed the CD-R on MPD INV #18030854, item 1 of 1, as evidence. The video depicts a fight between two subjects outside and in front of the premises where one of the actors appears to sustain an injury to the face/head that would likely have required medical attention. The video shows a crowd watching the fight and at least one of the subjects in the crowd is observed wearing a black shirt with "security" across the back at shoulder height. P.O. VODICKA did also contact Gene GENAL of Cornerstone Security Group regarding security cameras in the area. GENAL stated that there is a camera at 3412 W National Av, but that the video is no longer available due to the older equipment and smaller hard drive that retains the video.

There are no corresponding calls for service regarding this incident.

On Wednesday, August 1, 2018 at approximately 1:00 AM I conducted a tavern check at 3412 W. National Ave to investigate the fight that was recorded and displayed on facebook. I spoke to bartender Latasha R. TIPPETT who stated she was working on Saturday night at Gene's Unicorn Bar.

TIPPETT stated it was a busy night because they had two birthday parties going on. TIPPETT stated they closed the bar at approximately 2:00 AM. TIPPETT stated everyone was outside by 2:15 AM. She stated she was cleaning the bar when she heard a commotion outside. She stated the security guard who she knows as Jammie and her walked outside but everybody had left. TIPPETT stated she didn't call police because the incident was over by the time she went outside.


